Please be advised that Chief Hoskin would like to call a special council meeting following the September Executive and Finance meeting scheduled on the 24th at 3 p.m.

Recently Chief Hoskin's office worked to draft monumental legislation titled the Cherokee Heritage Center Act of 2020.

The purpose of this Act is to facilitate the transfer of Cherokee archives and collections of the Cherokee Heritage Center to Cherokee Nation. To establish a new Cherokee National Historical Society organized under the laws of the Cherokee Nation as a successor to the Cherokee National Historical Society, Inc., organized under the laws of the State of Oklahoma in 1963. To authorize Council appropriations and relevant executive branch memoranda of agreement consistent with the purposes and policies of this Act.

Please schedule the special council meeting **starting at 3:45 p.m. on 9/24** to be held in the Council meeting area and to discuss only one business item, which we anticipate will be approved by the Rules committee earlier in the day:
