




## TOTAL AMBULATORY PATIENTS VISITS March 2015-2017






## **RX BY SITE MARCH 2017**



## **Dental Services Trend March 2015- 2017**




## Emergancy/Urgent care Trend at CN WW Hastings Hospital March 2015- 2017


