Month/Year of the report: July 2017

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Accomplishments:

• Staffing: Active announcements out for Chief of Family Medicine, Chief of Surgery, Chief of Adult Medicine Clinic and staff Surgeon. Interviewed two full time and one locum surgeon.

• Visits: Outpatient visits for July up 6.1% over the same period the previous year.

• Revenues: Revenues for FY2017 increased 17.46% over the same period the previous year.

Future Plans / New Initiatives:

• New Services:

- o Orthopedic patients still being sent to Dr. Wheeler's Group in OKC. Still waiting review by Hillcrest Legal Department.
- Remodel work for Women's Health progressing. ER remodel has been awarded. Surgery Clinic remodel completed
- o Remodel on ECHO room for cardiology nurse nearing completion.
