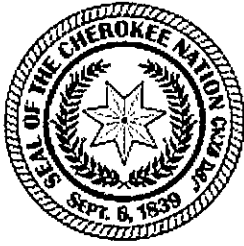

- Cherokee Nation's Male Seminary Recreation Center celebrated 10 years of service to the Cherokee people.

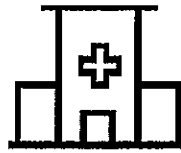

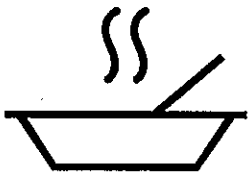

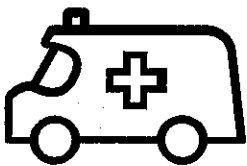

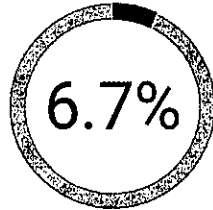

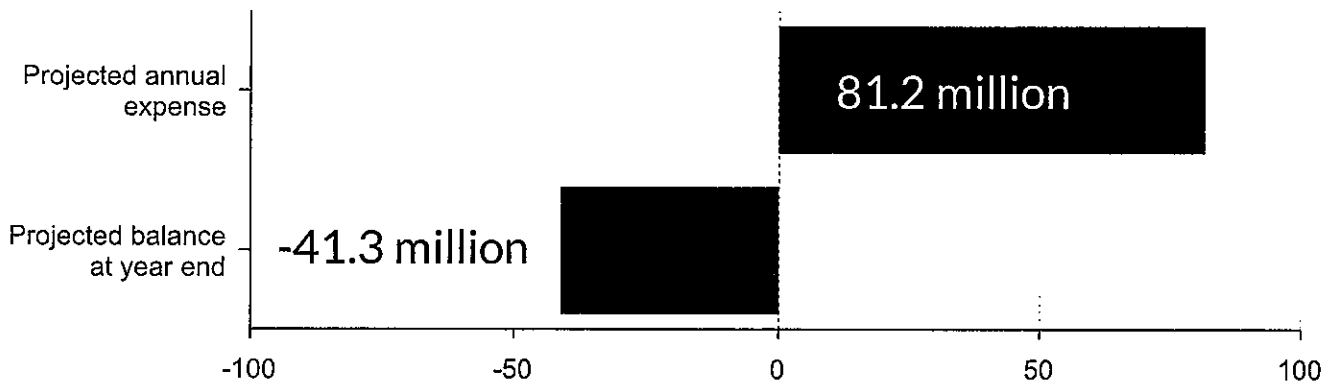

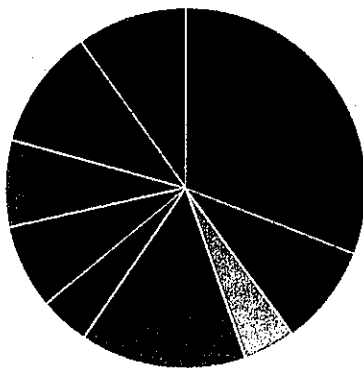

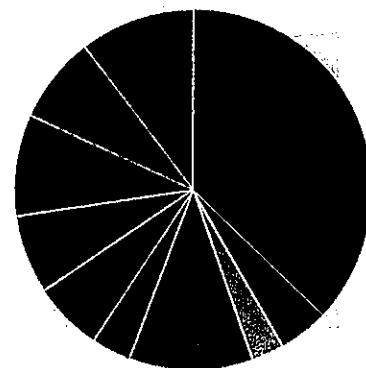


Monthly Visits by Location

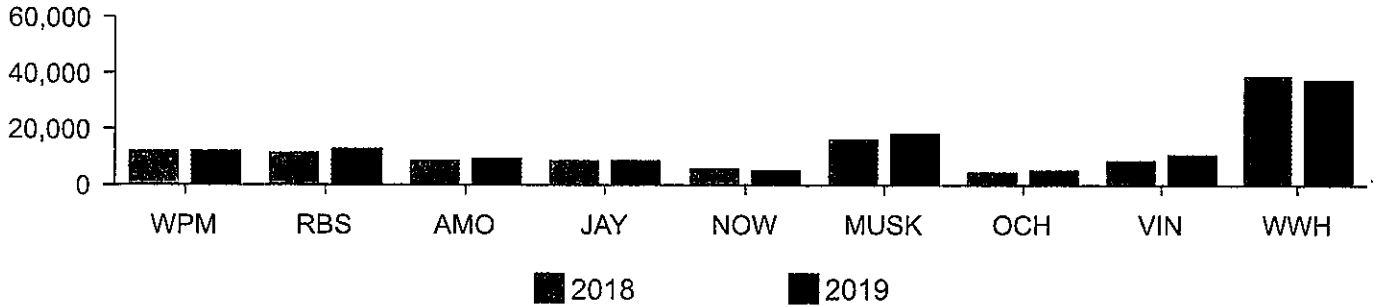
YTD CHS Spend by Location



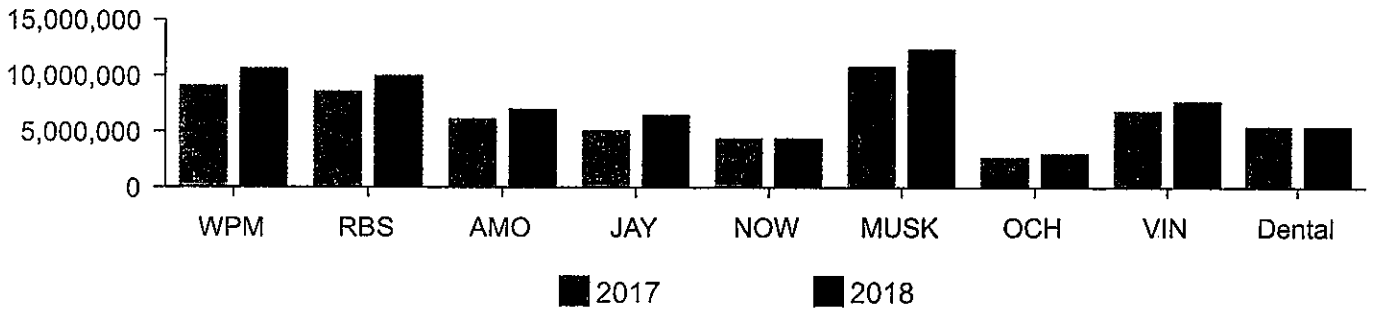

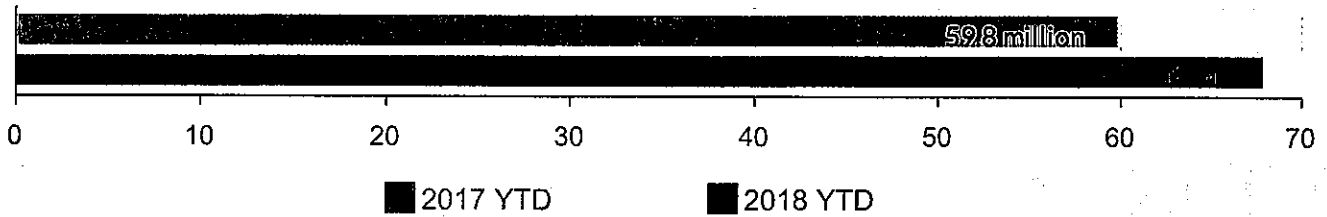
Ambulatory Care Visits: Monthly



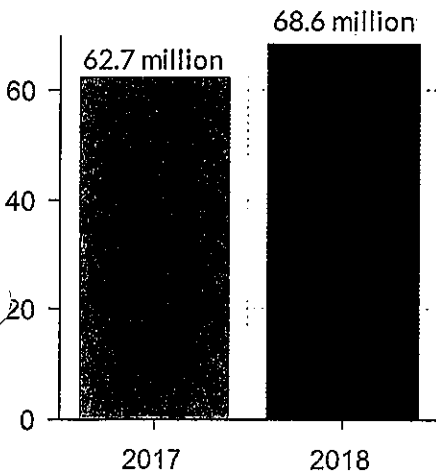
Ambulatory Care Revenue YTD



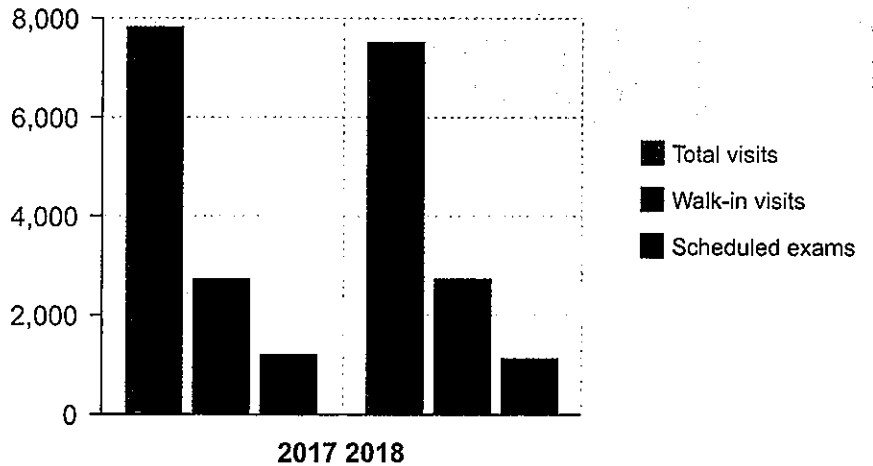
Health Center and Dental Revenue Year to Date



WWH 3rd party revenue Year to Date



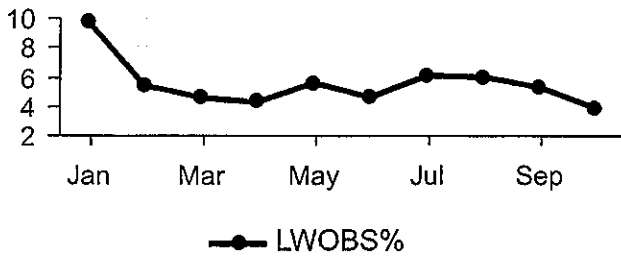

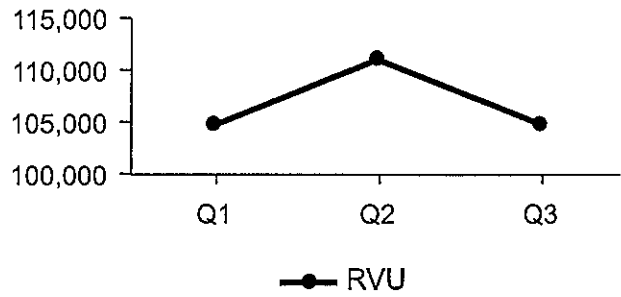

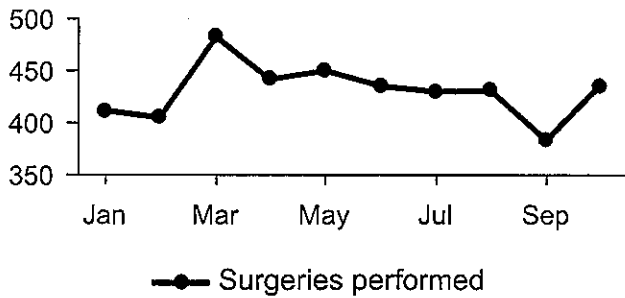

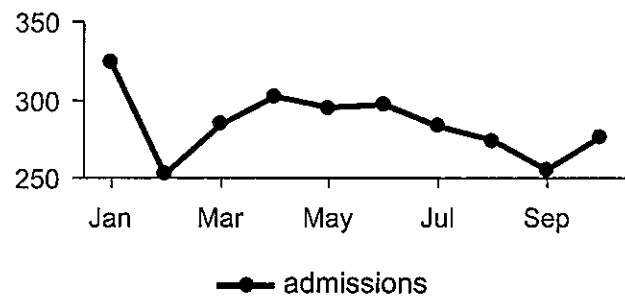

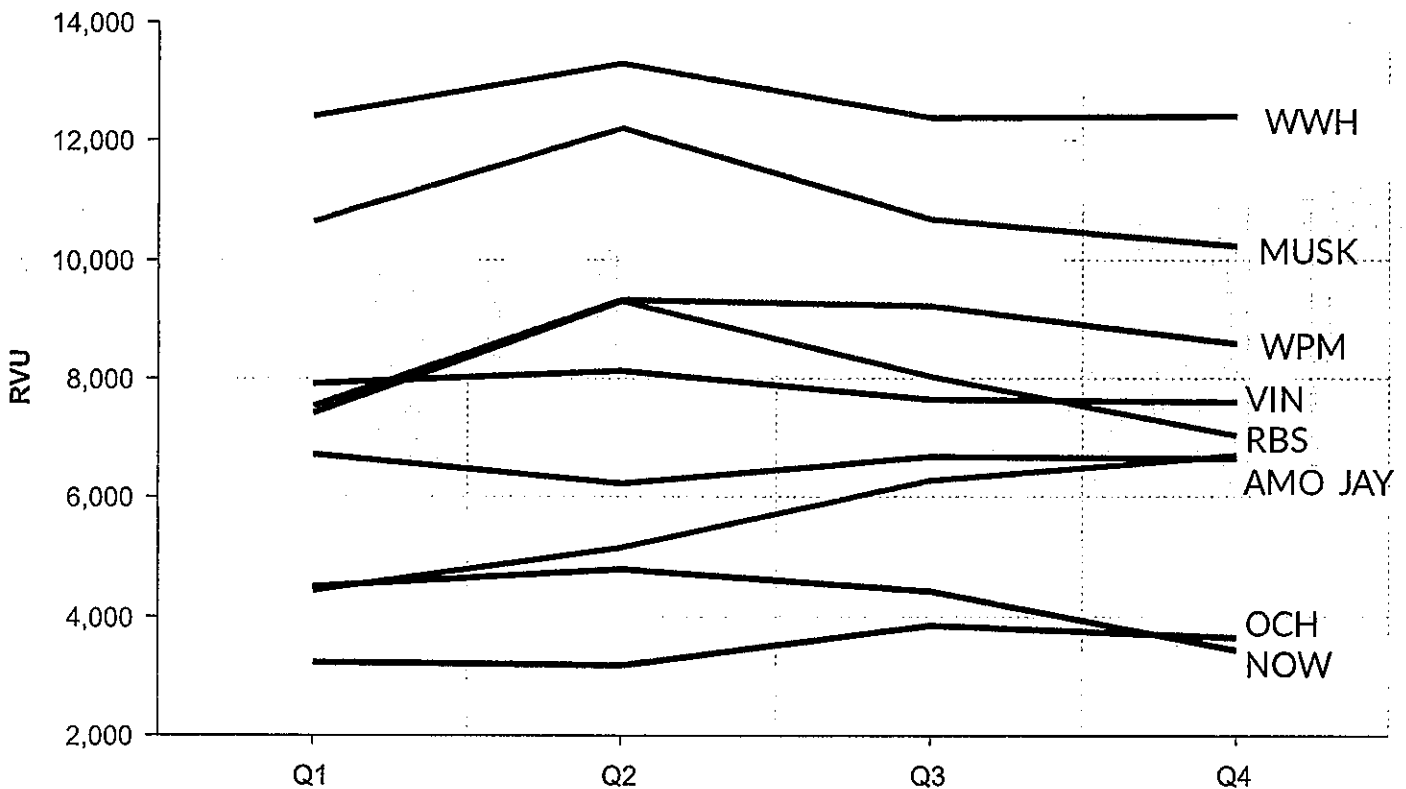

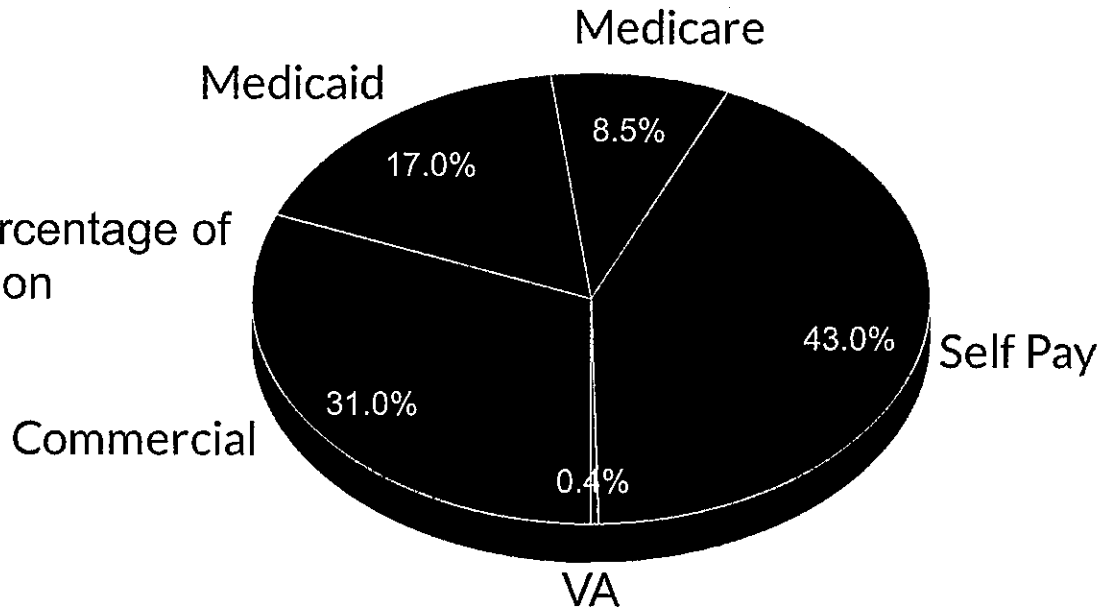
Service Delivered by Quarter

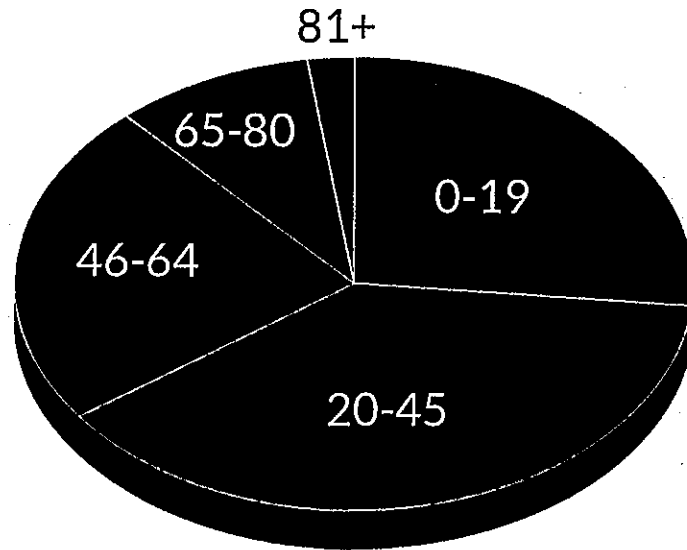
Payors as a percentage of patient population
