Description of Budget exceptions: No budget exceptions to report. SG Analyst position remains vacant. A panel has been prepared for interviews.

# II. Program Highlights

## a. In brief:

- 1. Contract Support Costs: Briefed administration on contract support cost claims with DOI and IHS. Conferred with Lloyd Miller regarding CSC CDA claims with both agencies in light of the US Supreme Court case. A privileged and confidential memo prepared by Lloyd Miller has been provided in a separated attachment to this report. Claims are prepared and submitted by SG staff in order to reduce legal costs to the tribe, however all information and correspondence is provided to outside counsel as well as administration.
- 2. Contract Disputes Act Claims- IHS CSC: Claims have been filed previously for unpaid CSC for 2005 thru 2010 totaling \$29,227,182. Claims have been drafted for years 2011 & 2012 in the amount of \$677,450.
- 3. Contract Disputes Act Claims- IHS CSC Supplemental Claim: Claims have been previously submitted to IHS for consequential expectancy damages for failure to pay CSC during FY2005 in the amount of \$1,554,564. Supplemental claims have been drafted for years 2006 thru 2010 in the amount of \$17,119,767. Awaiting information from Health Services in order to draft 2011 & 2012.
- **4.** Contract Disputes Act Claims- DOI CSC: Claim previously submitted to DOI for unpaid CSC for the fiscal year 2005 in the estimated amount of \$381,248. Claims will be drafted for years 2006 through 2011 as soon as possible.
- 5. OST Trust Review and Audit: On-site review was conducted in late March. Continued to provide information as requested to complete the review. A report is pending from the agency.
- 6. Tribal Data Exchange: June 4, directed a meeting with TDE representatives from Chickasaw Nation and Real Estate Services regarding the Nations participation as a pilot project for data collection of realty measures to be utilized for the national TDE data base. July 6 will be the first electronic submission of current measures identified within the system.
- 7. Delaware: June 6, facilitated a conference call between CN Community Services staff and Delaware officials to collaborate on 3 IHS Construction Project Agreements. A meeting scheduled for June 15 to discuss coordination with various programs and administration regarding the Delaware MOU and status of payments was cancelled and is in process of being rescheduled.
- 8. SHS Construction: Submitted request for contingency funds as well as an extension to close the contract to September 30, 2012. Continue to assist program staff with construction schedule to meet deadline and close the contract. Extension approved and contingency funds awarded in the amount of \$298,821. UPDATE: Meeting scheduled to discuss finalization and close out.
