Cheryl Hamby- Attended the 13th National Indian Nations Conference-Justice for Victims of Crime. Attended State Court Hearings in the following counties: Washington County, Sequoyah County, Adair County, Muskogee County, Wagoner County. Attended tribal court hearings relating to Criminal, Juvenile, and Child Support. File a Juvenile Appeal through the Oklahoma Supreme Court.

Nancy Rineheart- Attended Muskogee County Protective Order Hearings, Weekly. Attended D.A.C. Roundtable Meeting, hosted Victim Services Table for the OAG at the Adair County Community Tribal Counselors Meeting, assisted Victims of Domestic Violence in Muskogee, Mayes, Adair, Cherokee and Rogers Counties.

Nikki Baker- filed approximately 10 new criminal cases, two delinquent petitions and one In Need of Supervision petition. Attended four trainings, one hour long for CLE and conducted meetings with the Marshal Service on several occasions. Spoke at the Marshal's quarterly meeting about what is needed from them for the AG's office to prosecute cases and work more closely together. Attended the Crime Victims Rights meeting held in the Osiyo room that included area and State wide representatives to address working together on behalf of victims. Attended court to handle criminal and juvenile cases for the Cherokee Nation. Attended the Multi-disciplinary Team Meeting. Met Child Welfare and Federal prosecutor, Dean Burris, on cases involving our Indian children. Attended our Domestic Violence monthly meeting in which different departments share ideas and give updates on helping these type victims. Working on the ONE FIRE against Violence initiative and gathering all information needed in order to apply for an upcoming grant. Staffed cases with Indian Child Welfare to see how our office can better serve them and vice versa.

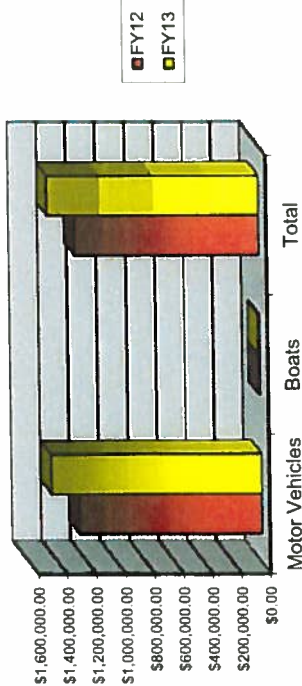

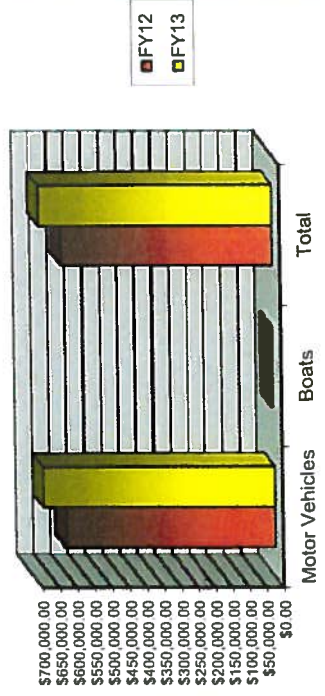

MV Gross Revenue Comparison - Year to Date

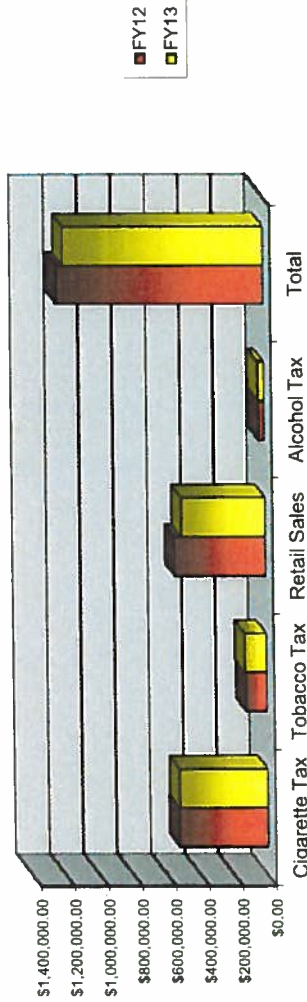

MV Gross Revenue Comparison - Month to Month

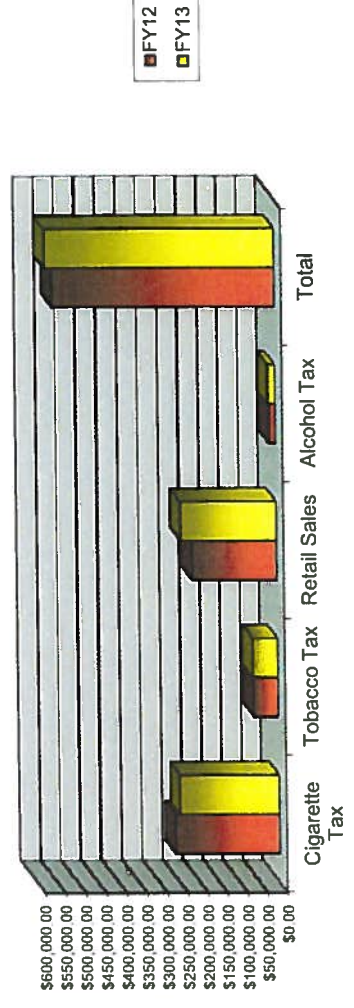


R & T Gross Revenue Comparison Year to Date
