### LEGISLATIVE ACT 12-23

AN ACT AMENDING LEGISLATIVE ACT #30-22 AUTHORIZING THE COMPREHENSIVE OPERATING BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023 – Mod. 8 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION:

### SECTION 1. TITLE AND CODIFICATION

This legislative act shall be titled and codified as "An Act Amending Legislative Act #30-22 Authorizing the Comprehensive Operating Budget for FY 2023 – Mod. 8".

### **SECTION 2. PURPOSE**

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize and approve the use of funds, subject to the availability of such funds, in accordance with Section 4, changing the amounts of certain cost centers approved in the "Comprehensive Budget Act for Fiscal Year 2023" or subsequent amendment. The cumulative total of the budget is increased by § 4,848,222 for a total budget authority of § 3,183,114,698. The following items are identified as components of such change:

Grants Received & Authorized per LA 30-22 (detail attached) \$ 1,306,461

Modification Request (see Section 4 below) 3,541,761

Cumulative change in budget authority \$ 4,848,222

### **SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE HISTORY**

The provisions of compliance, policy of accountability, authorities and severability provided in Legislative Act #30-22 are applicable to this amendment.

### **SECTION 4. FUNDING AUTHORIZATIONS**

The changes reflect increases to cost centers set forth in the program budget justifications incorporated herein. This modification request changes the total amount of the comprehensive budget authorization by an increase of § 3,541,761 to wit:

- A. An increase in the Tribally Funded budget authority of § 44,900.
- B. An increase in the Motor Fuel Tax budget authority of \$ 2,000,000.
- C. An increase in the **Internal Leases** budget authority of \$\\$\frac{\$1,033,029.}{}
- D. An increase in the DOI Self Governance budget authority of § 463,832.

### **SECTION 5. PROVISIONS AS CUMULATIVE**

The provisions of this Act shall be cumulative to existing law.

### SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Act are severable and if any part or provision hereof shall be held void, the decision of the court so holding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts or provisions of this Act.

### SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE: EMERGENCY DECLARED

It being immediately necessary for the welfare of the Cherokee Nation, the Council hereby declares that an emergency exists, by reason whereof this Act shall take effect immediately upon its approval and signatures.

### **SECTION 8. SELF-HELP CONTRIBUTIONS**

To the extent that this Act involves programs or services to citizens of the Nation or others, self-help contributions shall be required, unless specifically prohibited by the funding agency, or a waiver is granted due to physical or mental incapacity of the participant to contribute.

Review of Operating Budget Mod #8 - Total \$ 4,848,222

Per your request, I have reviewed the administration's budget modification request for this month's Executive & Finance Committee Meeting. Below is a summary of my review:

### A. Grant Reporting:

### B. MOD #8 Request - Increase in budget authority - \$ 3,541,761

- 1. <u>Unappropriated Reserve 1010296 Tribally Funded:</u> Modification requesting a decrease in expenditure authorization of \$491,116 to provide funding for the Cherokee National Holiday budget in budget 2. \$2 million is also budgeted as a transfer out to the MFT Higher Education Scholarships budget in 3. The new budgeted reserve by appropriation total is \$2,641,455.
- 2. <u>Cherokee National Holiday 1013000 Tribally Funded:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$536,016 and increased income of \$44,900. The increase is

for inflation cost, live music, and the first CNH livestock show. The net increase is funded by a decrease in the reserved by appropriation general fund carryover in budget 1. The new budgeted net expenditure total is \$778,005.

3. MFT Higher Ed Scholarships — 1024001— Motor Fuel Tax: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$2,000,000 to fund an estimate of the fall semester (see note 1 below) and also increase the funding from \$2,000 to \$2,250. The funding is provided by General Fund carryover through budget 1. The new expenditure total is \$17,119,000. This budget is shown to be a Motor Fuel Tax (MFT) budget but the majority of funding is Tribally Funded:

Note 1: 2022 Transfers were made at the budget amount and actual expenditures were \$1.6 million less. This carryover balance will be used in a budget mod in a couple months when the actual fall 2023 need is known.

- 4. <u>Internal Lease Buildings 2131000 Internal Leases:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$951,429 and increased recovery revenue of \$1,007,445 related to adding several CARES Act buildings to the lease pool. Net related recovery revenue and expenditures with this budget and the Facilities Operations net to zero. The new budgeted expenditure total is \$2,880,951.
- 5. <u>Facilities Operations 2132000 Internal Leases:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$81,600 and increased recovery revenue of \$25,584. Net related recovery revenue and expenditures with this budget and Internal Lease Buildings net to zero. The new budgeted expenditure total is \$3,630,889.
- 6. <u>SG General Assistance 3222220 DOI Self Governance:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$463,832. Additional funding provided by Authority to Obligate "ATO" #2. The new budgeted expenditure total is \$1,888,832.

#### Summary:

After reviewing the submission of the operating modification by administration, I find no technical issues surrounding these requests, nor do I have any unmentioned concerns related to their
