AN ACT AMENDING LEGISLATIVE ACT #30-22 AUTHORIZING THE COMPREHENSIVE OPERATING BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023 – Mod. 2; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION:

SECTION 1. TITLE AND CODIFICATION

This legislative act shall be titled and codified as "An Act Amending Legislative Act #30-22 Authorizing the Comprehensive Operating Budget for FY 2023 – Mod. 2".

SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize and approve the use of funds, subject to the availability of such funds, in accordance with Section 4, changing the amounts of certain cost centers approved in the "Comprehensive Budget Act for Fiscal Year 2023" or subsequent amendment. The cumulative total of the budget is increased by \$ 3,637,483 for a total budget authority of \$3,026,756,779. The following items are identified as components of such change:

Grants Received & Authorized per LA 30-22 (detail attached) \$ 2,454,389 Modification Request (see Section 4 below) 1,183,094 3,637,483 Cumulative change in budget authority

SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

The provisions of compliance, policy of accountability, authorities and severability provided in Legislative Act #30-22 are applicable to this amendment.

SECTION 4. FUNDING AUTHORIZATIONS

The changes reflect increases to cost centers set forth in the program budget justifications incorporated herein. This modification request changes the total amount of the comprehensive budget authorization by an increase of \$ 1,183,094 to wit:

- A. An increase in the **Tribally Funded** budget authority of \$ 110,000.
- B. An increase in the **DOI Self Governance** budget authority of § 65,181.
- C. An increase in the IHS Self Governance Health budget authority of \$ 1,007,913.

SECTION 5. PROVISIONS AS CUMULATIVE

The provisions of this Act shall be cumulative to existing law.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Act are severable and if any part or provision hereof shall be held void, the decision of the court so holding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts or provisions of this Act.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE: EMERGENCY DECLARED

It being immediately necessary for the welfare of the Cherokee Nation, the Council hereby declares that an emergency exists, by reason whereof this Act shall take effect immediately upon its approval and signatures.

SECTION 8. <u>SELF-HELP CONTRIBUTIONS</u>

To the extent that this Act involves programs or services to citizens of the Nation or others, self-help contributions shall be required, unless specifically prohibited by the funding agency, or a waiver is granted due to physical or mental incapacity of the participant to contribute.

Per your request, I have reviewed the administration's budget modification request for this month's Executive & Finance Committee Meeting. Below is a summary of my review:

B. MOD #2 Request - Increase in budget authority - \$ 1,183,094

1. <u>Registration Gen Fund – 1010045 – Tribally Funded:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$225,878 to add four new clerk positions and supplies. Funded from General Fund carryover and removed from the reserve by appropriation in budget 3. The new expenditure total is \$1,596,869.

- 2. <u>Institutional Aid Scholarship 1010178 Tribally Funded:</u> New budget requesting expenditure authorization of \$210,000. \$110,000 was funded in fiscal year 2022 and was unused and carried over. The additional \$100,000 is funded from General Fund carryover and removed from the reserve by appropriation in budget 3.
- 3. <u>Unappropriated Reserve 1010296 Tribally Funded:</u> Modification requesting a decrease in expenditure authorization of \$(1,658,455) in the Reserve by Appropriation account, to provide funding for the budgets 1, 2, 4 in this operating mod and the \$1,000,000 for the Real Property Acquisitions in the capital mod. The funding is provided by General Fund carryover.
- 4. <u>Supreme Court 1010800 Tribally Funded:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$332,577 to raise the Justice salaries to match the Tribal Council. Funded from General Fund carryover and removed from the reserve by appropriation in budget 3. The new expenditure total is \$1,612,149.
- HJSCA Lang Svc Spkr Hsng Rehab 1010926 Tribally Funded: New budget requesting expenditure authorization of \$1,000,000 of the \$10,000,000 authorized for fiscal years 2022-2025 per the Housing, Jobs and Sustainable Community Act of 2022 (LA 10-22). Funding is provided by special dividend from CNB.
- 6. <u>SG Registration 3222180 DOI Self Governance:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$65,181 one new staff position. The new budgeted expenditure total is \$1,324,862.
- Behavioral Health 3324000 DOI PL 102-477: Modification requesting and increase in expenditure authorization of \$549,120 for increased contractual expenses to bring on three full time providers to provide telehealth services. Third party collections related to their services will provide the funding. The new budgeted expenditure and transfer total is \$6,280,530.
- 8. <u>Health Administration 3325400 IHS Self Governance Health:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$458,793. Five new positions are added including: Patient Experience Manager and two Patient Services Advocates to serve as patient navigators, one Project Manager and Special Projects Officer to support the Deputy Director of External Operations with various projects. Also replaced one Administrative Assistant with a Health Administrative Coordinator. The new budgeted expenditure total is \$1,509,882.

Summary:

After reviewing the submission of the operating modification by administration, I find no technical issues surrounding these requests, nor do I have any unmentioned concerns related to their respective carryover estimates.
