LEGISLATIVE ACT 47-12

AN ACT AMENDING LEGISLATIVE ACT #37-12 AUTHORIZING THE COMPREHENSIVE OPERATING BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2013 – Mod. 3; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION:

SECTION 1. TITLE AND CODIFICATION

This legislative act shall be titled and codified as "An Act Amending Legislative Act #37-12 Authorizing the Comprehensive Operating Budget for FY 2013 - Mod. 3".

SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize and approve the use of funds, subject to the availability of such funds, in accordance with Section 4, changing the amounts of certain cost centers approved in the "Comprehensive Budget Act for Fiscal Year 2013" or subsequent amendment. The cumulative total of the budget is increased by \$3,883,520 for a total budget authority of \$532,193,180. The following items are identified as selective General Fund sources in excess of appropriated uses to wit:

SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

The provisions of compliance, policy of accountability, authorities and severability provided in Legislative Act #37-12 are applicable to this amendment.

SECTION 4. FUNDING AUTHORIZATIONS

The changes reflect increases to cost centers set forth in the program budget justifications incorporated herein. This modification request changes the total amount of the comprehensive budget authorization by an increase of \$559,742 to wit:

A. An increase in the **General Fund** budget authority of \$ 40,711.

B. An increase in the **Indirect Cost Pool** budget authority of \$ 137,688.

C. An increase in the Enterprise budget authority of \$195,302.

D. A decrease in the **DOI – PL 102-477** budget authority of < \$ 9,261>.

E. An increase in the **Federal Other** budget authority of \$195,302.

F. Budget reallocation in the IHS – Self Governance Health of \$3,500,000 for consent approval with a change in budget authority of \$0.

SECTION 5. PROVISIONS AS CUMULATIVE

The provisions of this Act shall be cumulative to existing law.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Act are severable and if any part or provision hereof shall be held void the decision of the court so holding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts or provisions of this Act.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE: EMERGENCY DECLARED

It being immediately necessary for the welfare of the Cherokee Nation, the Council hereby declares that an emergency exists, by reason whereof this Act shall take effect immediately upon its approval and signatures.

SECTION 8. SELF-HELP CONTRIBUTIONS

To the extent that this Act involves programs or services to citizens of the Nation or others, self-help contributions shall be required, unless specifically prohibited by the funding agency, or a waiver is granted due to physical or mental incapacity of the participant to contribute.

Review of Operating Budget Modification #3

Per your request, I have reviewed the administration's budget modification request for this month's Executive & Finance Committee Meeting. Below is a summary of my review:

A. OCTOBER GRANTS RECEIVED (REPORTING ONLY):

B. MOD - 3 (10 budgets) Increase in budget authority - \$559,742:

- 1. <u>Cherokee Immersion Program:</u> New budget request of \$450,000 to track Immersion separate from Charter. Offset by reduction in Charter School budget in 2.
- 2. <u>Cherokee Charter School:</u> Requesting a reduction of \$450,000 to budget the Immersion Programs separately in 1.
- 3. <u>Emergency Assistance Program:</u> Modification requesting expenditure authorization for \$18,250 in donations to Human Services. This will be a net zero affect for the budget.
- 4. <u>Cherokee Publications GF:</u> Modification to increase expenditures by \$20,461 by offset from the new paid subscription/distribution system and \$1,100 transfer in from 5. CN Subscription Donations
- 5. <u>CN Publications Subscription Donations:</u> New budget request to account for Donations of \$2,000 and to transfer out the same amount split between 4. and 6.
- 6. <u>Cherokee Publications IDC:</u> Modification to increase expenditures by \$16,739 by offset from the new paid subscription/distribution system and \$900 transfer in from 5. CN Subscription Donations.
- 7. Registration IDC: Modification requesting an increase in expenditures authorization of \$120,949 mostly related to increased costs for the new photo ID system. Detailed description in packet.

- 8. <u>PL102 477 Combined Interest:</u> Modification requesting a decrease in expenditure authorization of \$9,261 down to actual carryover interest and more accurate interest income amounts.
- 9. <u>Health Land/Building Purchase:</u> Modification requesting expenditure authorization to move \$3,500,000 from the Reserved by Appropriation account to the Capital Acquisitions account. No detail on specific projects is provided.
- 10. <u>2011 Community Development Financial Institutions (CFDI) Grant:</u> New budget requesting expenditure authorization of the \$195,302 grant balance, which is being transferred to the Commercial Loan Fund 10.
- 11. <u>Commercial Loan Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$195,302 from a transfer in from the CFDI Grant 9.

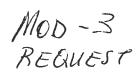
