LEGISLATIVE ACT 12-13

AN ACT AMENDING LEGISLATIVE ACT #37-12 AUTHORIZING THE COMPREHENSIVE OPERATING BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2013 – Mod. 7a; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION:

SECTION 1. TITLE AND CODIFICATION

This legislative act shall be titled and codified as "An Act Amending Legislative Act #37-12 Authorizing the Comprehensive Operating Budget for FY 2013 – Mod. 7a".

SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize and approve the use of funds, subject to the availability of such funds, in accordance with Section 4, changing the amounts of certain cost centers approved in the "Comprehensive Budget Act for Fiscal Year 2013" or subsequent amendment. The cumulative total of the budget is increased by \$18,998,971 for a total budget authority of \$560,549,044. The following items are identified as selective General Fund sources in excess of appropriated uses to wit:

SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

The provisions of compliance, policy of accountability, authorities and severability provided in Legislative Act #37-12 are applicable to this amendment.

SECTION 4. FUNDING AUTHORIZATIONS

The changes reflect increases to cost centers set forth in the program budget justifications incorporated herein. This modification request changes the total amount of the comprehensive budget authorization by an increase of \$18,689,086 to wit:

- B. An increase in the Indirect Cost Pool budget authority of § 21,600.
- C. An increase in the **Internal Leases** budget authority of § 3,000.
- D. An increase in the **DOI Self Governance** budget authority of \$ 189,468.

SECTION 5. PROVISIONS AS CUMULATIVE

The provisions of this Act shall be cumulative to existing law.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Act are severable and if any part or provision hereof shall be held void the decision of the court so holding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts or provisions of this Act.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE: EMERGENCY DECLARED

It being immediately necessary for the welfare of the Cherokee Nation, the Council hereby declares that an emergency exists, by reason whereof this Act shall take effect immediately upon its approval and signatures.

SECTION 8. SELF-HELP CONTRIBUTIONS

To the extent that this Act involves programs or services to citizens of the Nation or others, self-help contributions shall be required, unless specifically prohibited by the funding agency, or a waiver is granted due to physical or mental incapacity of the participant to contribute.

Per your request, I have reviewed the budget modification request for changes made during the March 28th Executive & Finance Committee Meeting. Below is a summary of my review:

MOD – 7a (6 budgets) Increase in budget authority - \$944,500 bringing the total increase for the mod to \$18,689,086:

- 1. <u>Charitable Contributions 1010042 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$7,500 for the Pocahontas Club. Original submission increased expenditure authorization \$30,000 for a donation to the Shriners to purchase a van.
- 2. <u>ICW Child Protection 1010147 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$300,000.
- 3. General Fund Operations 1010280 General Fund: Modification required for \$150,000 Transfer Out to DOI-Real Estate Services in item 6 and \$87,000 reduction in carryover show on Tribal Council budget in item 5. Estimated carryover and the \$5,000,000 in Reserved by Appropriation are shown as in the original submission. Estimated unappropriated carryover shown in this mod is \$2,419,806; however, based on final numbers after the audit the unappropriated carryover is \$4,604,806.
- 4. <u>Vocational Assistance 1010569 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$250,000 in addition to the request in the original submission of \$94,396. Total revised request is \$344,396 for continued vocational training for tribal members.
- 5. <u>Tribal Council 1010700 -- General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$87,000 from carryover funds. \$67,000 is for elective travel carryover to community assistance per LP 01-09 and \$20,000 for additional Tri-Council expenses.
- 6. <u>SG Real Estate Services 3221000 DOI Self Governance:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$150,000 and offsetting Transfer In from General Fund shown in item 3.

After reviewing the submission of Mod-7a by administration per revisions made at the Executive and Finance Committee, I find no technical issues surrounding these requests, nor do I have any concerns related to their respective carryover estimates. Note: There were \$794,500 in General Fund appropriation revisions approved in the Executive and Finance Committee; however, for budget purposes there is \$944,500. This is due to the fact that the \$150,000 has to be approved as a Transfer From General Fund to DOI-Real Estate Services and the actual expenditure is appropriated in DOI-Real Estate Services budget so the \$150,000 is actually appropriated twice.

MOD - 7 (22 budgets) Increase in budget authority - \$17,744,586: В.

- 1. Roads Transit Program 1010039 General Fund: New budget requesting expenditure authorization of \$75,000 to avoid any potential lapse in services while a couple other funding avenues are pursued.
- 2. Charitable Contributions 1010042 General Fund: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$30,000 for a donation to the Shriners to purchase a van.
- 3. Litigation 1010110 General Fund: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$800,000 due to increased litigation responsibilities mostly related to the issue related to the Indian Child Welfare Act.
- 4. Advocacy Initiative 1010115 General Fund: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$800,000 due to increased litigation responsibilities mostly related to the Freedman cases.
- 5. CN Water Plan 1010116 General Fund: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$315,000 to secure a contract extension for Natural Resources Consultant Engineers to perform the groundwater quantification in Phase 2.1 and water supply apportionment in Phase 2.2.
- 6. Concurrent Enrollment 1010177 General Fund: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$50,000 for additional tuition for juniors per recent legislation.

- 7. Community Recreation Center 1010249 General Fund: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$440,000. This replaces the reduction made during the FY2013 budget hearings and \$40,000 of increased revenue from customer fees. The original budget only provided funding for half a year. See related item 8.
- 8. <u>Contract Health GF 1010264 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$400,000 to replace the reduction during the FY2013 budget hearings to fund half a year of the Rec Center in item 7.
- 9. <u>General Fund Operations 1010280 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting recognition of the \$14,371,000 estimated carryover and placing \$5,000,000 in Reserved by Appropriation. After the reserve in this budget and increases for items 1 to 16 here, there is still \$3,214,306 estimated General Fund Carryover remaining.
- 10. <u>Indirect Cost Shortfall 1010310 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$200,000. Based on the actual FY 2012 shortfall of \$588,641 this budget modification is requesting an increase to \$600,000 to more accurately reflect the anticipated shortfall.
- 11. <u>Cash Match for Grants 1010315 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$1,500,000 to replenish the Reserved by Appropriation account for a recent reduction to fund an increase to the Election Commission and for additional anticipated cash match requirements.
- 12. Office of Veterans Affairs 1010380 General Fund: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$21,917 to furnish the new Veterans Center.
- 13. <u>Elders In Need 1010452 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$100,000 to cover the additional cost of adding 250 clients at \$400 each bringing the estimated elders served to 1,500.
- 14. Employee Performance Incentive 1010480 General Fund: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$206,000. \$250k of the \$291k current budget has already been spent to cover the raises not allowed by funding agencies and for the Christmas program. The increase will be used to cover the Employee Appreciation Day to be scheduled.
- 15. <u>Cherokee Day Training Program 1010555 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$1,100,000. As a comparison the net amount spent on this AU last year was \$1,872,420 and the net amount budgeted this year is \$2,211,064. The net amount excludes reimbursements from CNB.
- 16. <u>Vocational Assistance 1010569 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$94,396 for continued vocational training for tribal members. The client services portion of this budget is 98% spent with more commitments waiting.
- 17. <u>Contract Health Service Dividend (5%) 1010900 -- General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$6,483,824 funded by reserved carryover from FY 2012.
- 18. <u>Cherokee Publications GF 1011070 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$64,381 as detailed in a lengthy narrative submitted within the budget. Also see item 19 for IDC portion.
- 19. <u>Cherokee Publications IDC 2041030 Indirect Costs:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$21,600 as detailed in a lengthy narrative submitted with the budget. Also see item 18 for the General Fund portion.

- 20. <u>Internal Lease 2131000 Internal Service Leases:</u> Modification requesting a change in expenditure authorization of \$128,536 for additional recovered space cost relating to building being added to the Lease Pool: WPA Building, Patrick House, Immersion III, SIP House, Southgate G, and the Recycle Center. See offset in item 21.
- 21. <u>Facilities Operations 2132000 Internal Service Leases:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$128,536 for the addition of the buildings listed in item 20.
- 22. <u>BIA Competitive Projects 3221900 DOI Self Governance:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$39,468 for the balance of carryover grant funds available for the Tar Creek and National Zinc projects.
