LEGISLATIVE ACT 19-15

AN ACT AMENDING LEGISLATIVE ACT #17-15 AUTHORIZING THE COMPREHENSIVE OPERATING BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2016 – Mod. 2; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION:

SECTION 1. TITLE AND CODIFICATION

This legislative act shall be titled and codified as "An Act Amending Legislative Act #17-15 Authorizing the Comprehensive Operating Budget for FY 2016 – Mod. 2".

SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize and approve the use of funds, subject to the availability of such funds, in accordance with Section 4, changing the amounts of certain cost centers approved in the "Comprehensive Budget Act for Fiscal Year 2016" or subsequent amendment. The cumulative total of the budget is increased by \$\frac{\\$1,143,372}{\$}\$ for a total budget authority of \$\frac{\\$653,004,993.}{\$}\$ The following items are identified as components of such change:

Grants Received & Authorized per LA-17-15 (detail attached) \$ 169,567

Modification Request (see Section 4 below) 973,805

Cumulative change in budget authority \$ 1,143,372

SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

The provisions of compliance, policy of accountability, authorities and severability provided in Legislative Act #17-15 are applicable to this amendment.

SECTION 4. FUNDING AUTHORIZATIONS

The changes reflect increases to cost centers set forth in the program budget justifications incorporated herein. This modification request changes the total amount of the comprehensive budget authorization by an increase of § 973,805 to wit:

- A. An increase in the **General Fund** budget authority of § 853,412.
- B. An increase in the **Indirect Cost Pool** budget authority of \$93,413.
- C. An increase in the DOI Self Governance budget authority of \$ 26,980.

SECTION 5. PROVISIONS AS CUMULATIVE

The provisions of this Act shall be cumulative to existing law.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Act are severable and if any part or provision hereof shall be held void the decision of the court so holding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts or provisions of this Act.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE: EMERGENCY DECLARED

It being immediately necessary for the welfare of the Cherokee Nation, the Council hereby declares that an emergency exists, by reason whereof this Act shall take effect immediately upon its approval and signatures.

SECTION 8. SELF-HELP CONTRIBUTIONS

To the extent that this Act involves programs or services to citizens of the Nation or others, self-help contributions shall be required, unless specifically prohibited by the funding agency, or a waiver is granted due to physical or mental incapacity of the participant to contribute.

Per your request, I have reviewed the administration's budget modification request for this month's Executive & Finance Committee Meeting. Below is a summary of my review:

MOD #2 Request - (5 budgets) Increase in budget authority - \$ 973,805 B.

- 1. Attorney General 1010100 General Fund: Modification requesting an increase in the expenditure authorization of \$93,412 for increased assistant attorney general salaries and fringe costs. The offsetting revenue is received from a MOA with CNB to provide legal services to CNB. This General Fund budget is 50% of the change with the other 50% in the IDC pool budget - item 3. The new budget expenditure total is \$1,380,541; however, the net budget remains the same at \$1,281,829.
- 2. TERO Job Training Program 1015000 General Fund: Modification requesting an increase in the expenditure authorization of \$760,000 that is offset by an increase in TERO revenues based upon actuals from fiscal year 2015. The increase includes a 3.25 FTE increase with the majority of the overall increase going to client services, training and tuitions. The new budget expenditure total is \$1,758,000 and that is 100% offset by budgeted revenues.

- 3. Attorney General IDC Fund Indirect Cost Pool: Modification requesting an increase in the expenditure authorization of \$93,413 for increased assistant attorney general salaries and fringe costs. The offsetting revenue is received from a MOA with CNB to provide legal services to CNB. This Indirect Cost Pool budget is 50% of the change with the other 50% in the General Fund budget item 1. The new budget expenditure total is \$1,070,733; however, the net budget remains the same at \$977,320.
- 4. <u>CDIB Backlog Project 3221200 DOI Self Governance:</u> This is a new budget for fiscal year 2016 requesting expenditure authorization of \$11,980 funded by unexpended funds from fiscal year 2015. The budget for fiscal year 2015 was \$104,543 and actual expenditures were \$92,560.
- 5. <u>FWS Pollinator Project 3225100 DOI Self Governance:</u> This is a new budget requesting expenditure authorization of \$15,000 for a non-recurring grant received from the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service that flows through our DOI compact. Project narrative and additional details are attached with the budget.

Summary:

After reviewing the submission of Mod #2 by administration, I find no technical issues surrounding these requests, nor do I have any unmentioned concerns related to their respective carryover estimates. If I can provide any further information, please do not hesitate to contact me.
