LEGISLATIVE ACT 11-16

AN ACT AMENDING LEGISLATIVE ACT #17-15 AUTHORIZING THE COMPREHENSIVE OPERATING BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2016 – Mod. 6; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION:

SECTION 1. TITLE AND CODIFICATION

This legislative act shall be titled and codified as "An Act Amending Legislative Act #17-15 Authorizing the Comprehensive Operating Budget for FY 2016 – Mod. 6".

SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize and approve the use of funds, subject to the availability of such funds, in accordance with Section 4, changing the amounts of certain cost centers approved in the "Comprehensive Budget Act for Fiscal Year 2016" or subsequent amendment. The cumulative total of the budget is increased by § 5,440,583 for a total budget authority of § 663,072,472. The following items are identified as components of such change:

Grants Received & Authorized per LA-17-15 (detail attached) \$ 280,828

Modification Request (see Section 4 below) 5,159,755

Cumulative change in budget authority \$ 5,440,583

SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

The provisions of compliance, policy of accountability, authorities and severability provided in Legislative Act #17-15 are applicable to this amendment.

SECTION 4. FUNDING AUTHORIZATIONS

The changes reflect increases to cost centers set forth in the program budget justifications incorporated herein. This modification request changes the total amount of the comprehensive budget authorization by a decrease of § 5,159,755 to wit:

- A. An increase in the **General Fund** budget authority of § 4,211,330.
- B. An increase in the Motor Fuel Tax budget authority of § 914,000.
- C. An increase in the **DOI Self Governance** budget authority of \$237,105.

D. A decrease in the IHS – Self Governance budget authority of § (202,680).

SECTION 5. PROVISIONS AS CUMULATIVE

The provisions of this Act shall be cumulative to existing law.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Act are severable and if any part or provision hereof shall be held void the decision of the court so holding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts or provisions of this Act.

SECTION 7. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE: EMERGENCY DECLARED</u>

It being immediately necessary for the welfare of the Cherokee Nation, the Council hereby declares that an emergency exists, by reason whereof this Act shall take effect immediately upon its approval and signatures.

SECTION 8. SELF-HELP CONTRIBUTIONS

To the extent that this Act involves programs or services to citizens of the Nation or others, self-help contributions shall be required, unless specifically prohibited by the funding agency, or a waiver is granted due to physical or mental incapacity of the participant to contribute.

Per your request, I have reviewed the administration's budget modification request for this month's Executive & Finance Committee Meeting. Below is a summary of my review:

MOD #6 Request - (20 budgets) Increase in budget authority - \$ 5,159,755 В.

- 1. Roads Transit Program 1010039 General Fund: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$35,000 to help with the purchase of a transit bus. The new budget expenditure total is \$110,000.
- 2. Meth Initiative 1010145 General Fund: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$96,497. Though not specifically related to the Meth Initiative the one-time costs associated with relocation of the Marshal Service offices and equipment are included in this General Fund budget. The new budget expenditure total is \$256,960.
- 3. Concurrent Enrollment 1010177 General Fund: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$150,000 to cover the Fall 2016 Semester. The new budget expenditure total is \$350,000. As a comparison, the actual expenditure total for fiscal year 2015 was \$335,547.

- 4. <u>Community Youth Grant Program 1010248 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$125,000. The new budget expenditure total is \$475,000. As a comparison, the actual expenditure total for fiscal year 2015 was \$699,702; however, the qualifying age was increased this year, so the total expenditure should be reduced.
- 5. <u>General Fund Operations 1010280 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$300,000 for a subgrant to Cherokee Nation Waste Management. The new subgrant total is \$1,552,000.
- 6. <u>Unappropriated Reserves 1010296 General Fund:</u> New budget requesting expenditure authorization of \$3,000,996, of which \$914,000 is transferred to AU 1024001, MFT Higher Ed Scholarships and \$2,086,996 reserved by appropriation.
- 7. Office of Veterans Affairs 1010380 General Fund: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$42,338 for the 3rd Annual Cherokee Warrior Flight. The new budget expenditure total is \$358,175.
- 8. <u>CN Cemeteries Preservation 1010429 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting authority to use the Contribution and Donations account instead of the Client Services account. This is a zero dollar change.
- 9. <u>Self Help Emergency Assistance Program –1010430 –General Fund:</u> Modification requesting a change in expenditure authorization reducing direct expenditures and adding a \$170,000 subgrant to the HACN. This subgrant will allow them to operate the program for the balance of the fiscal year. The budget expenditure total remains at \$315,000.
- 10. <u>Community Water & Sewer 1010432 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$242,383 to carry out the construction of water and sewer facilities for communities. The new budget expenditure total is \$1,558,836.
- 11. Community Adult Education 1010439 General Fund: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$30,000 due to an increase in applications. The budget is currently 60% expended and we are less than 50% through the fiscal year. The new budget expenditure total is \$130,000.
- 12. <u>Human Service Emergency Asst 1010461 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$45,000. The new budget expenditure total is \$175,750. As a comparison, the budget for fiscal year 2015 was \$255.750 with \$254,925 actual expenditures.
- 13. <u>Jurisdictional Outreach 1010579 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$50,715 mainly for mailing and printing costs. The new budget expenditure total is \$163,215.
- 14. Remediating Juvenile Truancy 1010809 General Fund: New Budget requesting expenditure authorization of \$29,339 for startup costs in anticipation of expected grant funding. See the narrative attached behind the budget for detailed information.
- 15. <u>Cherokee National Holiday 1013000 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$64,062 to increase participation in traditional community games. The new budget expenditure total is \$275,934.
- 16. MFT Higher Ed Scholarships 1024001 Motor Fuel Tax: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$914,000 being transferred from the Unappropriated Reserve Fund in item 6. There is anticipated growth of 360 students over the fall 2015 semester count of 3,805. The new budget expenditure total is \$13,858,000. As the title of the accounting unit alludes to, these scholarships were originally funded from Motor Fuel Tax revenues. However, as you can see in the chart below the General

Fund is currently required to fund the majority of the higher education scholarships and continues to grow at a high rate. Increased dividend revenue is always talked about and people wonder where it is going — look to this budget and you will see where a good chunk of it is going. This is a wonderful program but I would be remiss in my fiscal duties if I don't continue to point out the funding problems that the continued growth of this program could cause.

- 17. <u>BIA Preparedness 3221105 DOI Self Governance:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$12,351 from additional one time funding. The new budget expenditure total is \$87,048.
- 18. <u>SG Indian Child Welfare 3222480 DOI Self Governance:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$239,754 from additional funding, some of which is one time funding. The new budget expenditure total is \$1,199,011.
- 19. <u>FWS Pollinator Project 3225100 DOI Self Governance:</u> Modification requesting the cancellation of this \$15,000 budget as it needed to be set up as non Self Governance grant funding in the DOI General funding source (3205110).
- 20. Meth and Suicide Prevention 3324040 IHS Self Governance Health: Modification requesting a decrease in expenditure authorization of \$202,680 due to no carryover available as previously budgeted. The new budget expenditure total is \$0 and the minor expenditures charged to this AU will need to be reallocated.

Summary:

After reviewing the submission of the operating modification by administration, I find no technical issues surrounding these requests, nor do I have any unmentioned concerns related to their respective carryover estimates.
