LEGISLATIVE ACT 14-16

AN ACT AMENDING LEGISLATIVE ACT #16-15 AUTHORIZING THE COMPREHENSIVE CAPITAL BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2016 – Mod. 3; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION:

SECTION 1. TITLE AND CODIFICATION

This legislative act shall be titled and codified as "An Act Amending Legislative Act #16-15 Authorizing the Comprehensive Capital Budget for FY 2016 – Mod. 3".

SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize and approve the use of funds, subject to the availability of such funds, in accordance with Section 4, changing the amounts of certain cost centers approved in the "Comprehensive Capital Budget Act for Fiscal Year 2016" or subsequent amendment. The cumulative total of the capital budget is increased by \$\frac{129,500}{291,821,842}\$ for a total capital budget authority of \$\frac{291,821,842}{291,821,842}\$. The following items are identified as the components of such change:

Cumulative change in budget authority	\$ 129,500
Modification Request (per Section 4 below)	129,500
Grants Received & Authorized per L.A. 16-15 (detail attached)	\$ 0

SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

The provisions of compliance, policy of accountability, authorities and severability provided in Legislative Act #16-15 are applicable to this amendment.

SECTION 4. FUNDING AUTHORIZATIONS

The changes reflect increases to cost centers set forth in the program budget justifications incorporated herein. This modification request changes the total amount of the comprehensive capital budget authorization by an increase of § 129,500 to wit:

A. An increase in the **General Fund** budget authority of \$\sqrt{129,500}.

SECTION 5. PROVISIONS AS CUMULATIVE

The provisions of this Act shall be cumulative to existing law.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Act are severable and if any part or provision hereof shall be held void the decision of the court so holding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts or provisions of this Act.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE: EMERGENCY DECLARED

It being immediately necessary for the welfare of the Cherokee Nation, the Council hereby declares that an emergency exists, by reason whereof this Act shall take effect immediately upon its approval and signatures.

SECTION 8. SELF-HELP CONTRIBUTIONS

To the extent that this Act involves programs or services to citizens of the Nation or others, self-help contributions shall be required, unless specifically prohibited by the funding agency, or a waiver is granted due to physical or mental incapacity of the participant to contribute.

Repairs are needed on the John A. Ketcher Youth Services Center, which houses the Youth Shelter. There has been a leak in the roof which continues to cause problems and has only been temporarily fixed over the years. There are also other maintenance issues that have not been addressed over the years and they have now created potential problems, such as an outdated sprinkler system, lack of handicap accessible bathroom, lack of generator, and inadequate outside lighting.

The following breakdown is immediate repairs that need to be performed to bring the operations of the Shelter up to date and ensure safe housing for the youth residents.
