LEGISLATIVE ACT 21-16

AN ACT AMENDING LEGISLATIVE ACT #17-15 AUTHORIZING THE COMPREHENSIVE OPERATING BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2016 - Mod. 11; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION:

SECTION 1. TITLE AND CODIFICATION

This legislative act shall be titled and codified as "An Act Amending Legislative Act #17-15 Authorizing the Comprehensive Operating Budget for FY 2016 - Mod. 11".

SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize and approve the use of funds, subject to the availability of such funds, in accordance with Section 4, changing the amounts of certain cost centers approved in the "Comprehensive Budget Act for Fiscal Year 2016" or subsequent amendment. The cumulative total of the budget is increased by \$ 2,182,122 for a total budget authority of \$\\$684,837,873. The following items are identified as components of such change:

Grants Received & Authorized per LA-17-15 (detail attached) \$ 1,325,203 Modification Request (see Section 4 below) 856,919 Cumulative change in budget authority **\$ 2,182,122**

SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

The provisions of compliance, policy of accountability, authorities and severability provided in Legislative Act #17-15 are applicable to this amendment.

SECTION 4. FUNDING AUTHORIZATIONS

The changes reflect increases to cost centers set forth in the program budget justifications incorporated herein. This modification request changes the total amount of the comprehensive budget authorization by a decrease of \$856,919 to wit:

- A. An increase in the **General Fund** budget authority of \$ 37,865.
- B. An increase in the **DOI Self Governance** budget authority of \$ 181,554.
- C. An increase in the IHS Self Governance TEH budget authority of § 337,500.

D. An increase in the NAHASDA budget authority of § 300,000.

SECTION 5. PROVISIONS AS CUMULATIVE

The provisions of this Act shall be cumulative to existing law.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Act are severable and if any part or provision hereof shall be held void the decision of the court so holding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts or provisions of this Act.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE: EMERGENCY DECLARED

It being immediately necessary for the welfare of the Cherokee Nation, the Council hereby declares that an emergency exists, by reason whereof this Act shall take effect immediately upon its approval and signatures.

SECTION 8. SELF-HELP CONTRIBUTIONS

To the extent that this Act involves programs or services to citizens of the Nation or others, self-help contributions shall be required, unless specifically prohibited by the funding agency, or a waiver is granted due to physical or mental incapacity of the participant to contribute.

Per your request, I have reviewed the administration's budget modification request for this month's Executive & Finance Committee Meeting. Below is a summary of my review:

B. MOD #1 Request - (10 budgets) Increase in budget authority - \$ 856,919

- 1. <u>Special Projects 1010390 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$25,000 that is funded from estimated contributions and donations for the Rodeo. The net expenditure total remains at \$233,620.
- 2. <u>One Fire Helping Victims 1016000 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of 12,865 funded by other income from the One Fire golf tournament. The new budget expenditure total is \$42,865.

- 3. <u>Information Technology 2041110 Indirect Cost Pool:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$330,046 for salary reclassification and career ladder promotions. This is funded by an equal reduction in the Network and Internet System budget in item 4. The new budget expenditure total is \$3,787,324.
- 4. <u>Network and Internet System 2041115 Indirect Cost Pool:</u> Modification requesting a decrease in expenditure authorization of \$330,046 to fund the increase for Information Technology in item 3. The new budget expenditure total is \$3,221,534.
- 5. <u>Competitive Projects 3221900 DOI Self Governance:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$21,554 for adjustments to new funding and carryover. The new budget expenditure total is \$206,554.
- 6. <u>SG General Assistance 3222220 DOI Self Governance:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$160,000. This is one time increase for General and Burial Assistance that is funded from DOI Self Governance carryover. The new budget net expenditure total is \$1,138,431.
- 7. <u>EHS Projects 3332000 IHS Self Governance TEH:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$337,500 for new funding received. The new budget expenditure total is \$6,003,265.
- 8. <u>Transitional Emergency Housing 33566060 NAHASDA:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$300,000 from NAHASDA funds. The new budget expenditure total is \$394,401.
- 9. <u>ADDED Cherokee Sports Teams 1010025 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$10,000 to provide funding for additional anticipated requests. Funding is provided by a reduction in the Cherokee Livestock Auctions budget. The new budget expenditure total is \$80,000.
- 10. <u>ADDED Cherokee Livestock Auctions 1010026 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting a decrease in expenditure of \$10,000 authorization to provide the funding for Cherokee Sports Teams. The new budget expenditure total is \$65,000.
