LEGISLATIVE ACT 11-18

AN ACT AMENDING LEGISLATIVE ACT #26-17 AUTHORIZING THE COMPREHENSIVE OPERATING BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018 – Mod. 7; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION:

SECTION 1. TITLE AND CODIFICATION

This legislative act shall be titled and codified as "An Act Amending Legislative Act #26-17 Authorizing the Comprehensive Operating Budget for FY 2018 – Mod. 7".

SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize and approve the use of funds, subject to the availability of such funds, in accordance with Section 4, changing the amounts of certain cost centers approved in the "Comprehensive Budget Act for Fiscal Year 2018" or subsequent amendment. The cumulative total of the budget is increased by \$20,150,723 for a total budget authority of \$687,142,846. The following items are identified as components of such change:

Grants Received & Authorized per LA-26-17 (detail attached) \$ (724,266)

Modification Request (see Section 4 below) 20,874,989

Cumulative change in budget authority \$ 20,150,723

SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

The provisions of compliance, policy of accountability, authorities and severability provided in Legislative Act #26-17 are applicable to this amendment.

SECTION 4. FUNDING AUTHORIZATIONS

The changes reflect increases to cost centers set forth in the program budget justifications incorporated herein. This modification request changes the total amount of the comprehensive budget authorization by an increase of \$20,874,989 to wit:

- A. An increase in the General Fund budget authority of § 9,454,354.
- B. An increase in the Motor Fuel Tax budget authority of \$ 1,977,983.
- C. An increase in the Indirect Cost Pool budget authority of § 118,589.
- D. An increase in the **DOI PL 102-477** budget authority of § 1,593,170.

- E. An increase in the **DOI Self Governance** budget authority of <u>\$ 295,845.</u>
- F. An increase in the IHS Self Governance Health budget authority of § 6,273,938.
- G. An increase in the IHS Self Governance TEH budget authority of \$ 1,161,110.
- H. Reallocation in the **NAHASDA** budget authority of § 0.

SECTION 5. PROVISIONS AS CUMULATIVE

The provisions of this Act shall be cumulative to existing law.

SECTION 6. <u>SEVERABILITY</u>

The provisions of this Act are severable and if any part or provision hereof shall be held void the decision of the court so holding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts or provisions of this Act.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE: EMERGENCY DECLARED

It being immediately necessary for the welfare of the Cherokee Nation, the Council hereby declares that an emergency exists, by reason whereof this Act shall take effect immediately upon its approval and signatures.

SECTION 8. SELF-HELP CONTRIBUTIONS

To the extent that this Act involves programs or services to citizens of the Nation or others, self-help contributions shall be required, unless specifically prohibited by the funding agency, or a waiver is granted due to physical or mental incapacity of the participant to contribute.

B. MOD #7 Request - (31 budgets) Increase in budget authority - \$20,874,989

- 1. Registration GF 1010045 General Fund: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$1,809. There is an increase in the space costs with a reallocation of a partial FTE to the DOI SG Registration budget. The funding is provided from General Fund carryover in item 4. The new expenditure total is \$859,713.
- 2. Concurrent Enrollment 1010177 General Fund: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$245,000. The original budget was \$275,200 of which approximately \$250K was spent for the spring semester which leaves approximately \$25K carryover to the fall. The additional \$245K plus the \$25K carryover will bring the fall budget to \$270K. This covers the recent legislative changes to this

program. The funding is provided from General Fund carryover in item 4. The new expenditure total for the year is \$520,200.

- 3. Cherokee Charter School 1010045 General Fund: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$322,898. A small portion is related to space cost but the majority is related to a reduction in funding from Oklahoma. The reduced funding from Oklahoma provides for less than one-fourth of the teacher pay with Cherokee Nation funding the remaining three fourths plus support staff and all operating expenditures. The reduced funding (penalty) from Oklahoma is probably best explained by the education department. The funding is provided from General Fund carryover in item 4. The new expenditure total is \$859,713.
- 4. <u>Unappropriated Reserves 1010296 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$9,304,380 for the fiscal year 2017 additional General Fund carryover. An additional \$6,094,323 is placed in the reserved by appropriation account. The reserved by appropriation balance is calculated as follows:

- 5. Office of Veterans Affairs 1010380 General Fund: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$106,335 for supplies and .55 FTE increase for a total 3 FTEs. The funding is provided by General Fund carryover in item 4. The new expenditure total is \$464,510.
- 6. <u>Community Water & Sewer 1010432 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$146,897. Funding is provided by assigned carryover specific to this budget. The new expenditure total is \$1,329,105.
- 7. <u>Senior Nutrition Sites 1010450 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$75,285. Funding is provided by General Fund carryover in item 4. This is an increase of \$50,000 for food and the partial year funding for a full time Nutrition Aid. The new expenditure total is \$424,496.
- 8. <u>Community Technical Assistance 1010575 General Fund:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$367,000. There are plus and minus reallocations all over this budget with the majority of the increase in contract services. Based on what I have been able to determine, most of the increase is related to the Community Works program. Funding is provided by General Fund carryover in item 4. The new expenditure total is \$1,604,373.
- 9. Focus Group for Cherokee Language and Culture 1010583 General Fund: New budget requesting expenditure authorization of \$38,162. There is a very lengthy narrative attached behind the budget explaining this budget. Funding is provided by General Fund carryover in item 4.

- 10. <u>Conservation District 1011059 General Fund:</u> New budget requesting expenditure authorization of \$27,771. This budget is related to setting up a new conservation district with the USDA and a detailed narrative is attached behind the budget. Funding is provided by General Fund carryover in item 4.
- 11. NRD Ethno Biology 1010575 General Fund: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$3,077. This increase budgets other income received from the University of Colorado and book royalties. The new expenditure total is \$97,589 with the net expenditure total remaining at \$94,512.
- 12. Cherokee Publications GF 1011070 General Fund: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$47,859 to provide for general operations of the Cherokee Phoenix newspaper for the remainder of the fiscal year. Funding for this budget (55% of total) is provided by General Fund carryover in item 4 with the remainder (45%) funded in an IDC budget further down the list. The new net expenditure total is \$520,026.
- 13. MFT Higher Ed Scholarships 1024001 Motor Fuel Tax: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$1,977,983. Funding is provided by a transfer in from General Fund carryover in item 4. The new expenditure total is \$14,921,983. This is a Motor Fuel Tax (MFT) budget but the majority of the funding in recent years is from the General Fund. For comparative purpose see the following:

- 14. <u>Indirect Cost Pool Recovery 2040000 Indirect Cost Pool:</u> Modification requesting an increase in IDC recovery revenue of \$118,589 to cover the increases in Cherokee Publications (item 15) and Information Technology (item 16).
- 15. Cherokee Publications IDC 2041030 Indirect Cost Pool: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$29,416 to provide for general operations of the Cherokee Phoenix newspaper for the remainder of the fiscal year. Funding for this budget (45% of total) is provided by Indirect Cost Pool Recovery (item 14) with the remainder (55%) funded by general fund carryover in budget item 12. The new net expenditure total is \$349,994.
- 16. <u>Information Technology IDC 2041110 Indirect Cost Pool:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$89,173 for some reorganization and the addition of two new Clerk III positions. Funding is provided by the Indirect Cost Pool Recovery budget in item 14. The new net expenditure total is \$4,384,915.
- 17. <u>Human Services Programs Management 2041185 Indirect Cost Pool:</u> Reallocation that removes .5 vacant FTE and adds to the contract services account for the TAM database system. The expenditure total remains at \$702,081.
- 18. Community Development 2041195 Indirect Cost Pool: Reallocation that removes .5 FTE and makes several reallocations within the budget. The expenditure total remains at \$507,161.

- 19. <u>SG Real Estate Services 3221000 DOI Self Governance:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$200,000 for contract services to help clear the probate backlog. The funding is provided by DOI Self Governance carryover. The new expenditure total is \$1,472,992.
- 20. Registration SG 3222180 DOI Self Governance: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$95,845 for a reallocation of a partial FTE from the Registration General Fund budget and for additional operational supplies. The funding is provided by DOI Self Governance carryover. The new expenditure total is \$952,199.
- 21. <u>PL 102-477 Employment and Training 3231000 DOI PL 102-477:</u> Modification requesting a decrease in expenditure authorization of \$1,105,618 to adjust to the carryover amount and reallocate FTEs and expenditures to the budget in item 22. The new expenditure total is \$694,382.
- 22. <u>PL 102-477 Career Services 3231100 DOI PL 102-477:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$2,698,788 to adjust to the carryover. FTEs are reallocated here from the budget in item 21with the major increases to educational support and tuition/scholarships. The new expenditure total is \$5,627,991.
- 23. <u>Contract Health Service 3324200 IHS Self Governance Health:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$4,000,000. Funding is provided by IHS Self Governance Health carryover. The carryover amount has not been finalized but this amount is within the estimated available balance. The new expenditure total is \$35,688,936.
- 24. <u>Dental 3324400 IHS Self Governance Health:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$2,033,888 for pay rate adjustments, reduced anticipated turnover, and merit increased adjusted to reflect actual pay. Funding is provided by increased Medicaid and insurance collections. The new expenditure total is \$20,372,403.
- 25. <u>Health Administration 3325400 IHS Self Governance Health:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$240,050 to provide funds for the WINGS program activities. Funding is provided by additional grant/contract revenue. The new expenditure total is \$1,778,113.
- 26. <u>EHS Administration 3331000 IHS Self Governance TEH:</u> Modification requesting a decrease in expenditure authorization of \$20,531 related to reduced carryover. The new expenditure total is \$3,106,014.

- 28. <u>Community Services Youth Development 3566048 NAHASDA:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$56,922. Funding is provided by the decrease in item 29. The new expenditure total is \$183,987.
- 29. <u>Self Sufficiency Counseling 3566049 NAHASDA:</u> Modification requesting a decrease in expenditure authorization of \$129,122 mainly for a reduction of FTEs for vacant positions. This reduction provides funding for the budgets in items 28, 30, and 31. The new expenditure total is \$511,696.
- 30. <u>Resident Adult Services 3566056 NAHASDA:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$50,019. Funding is provided by the decrease in item 29. The new expenditure total is \$179,362.
- 31. Mortgage Assistance Program 3566072 NAHASDA: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$22,181. Funding is provided by the decrease in item 29. The new expenditure total is \$573,157.
