LEGISLATIVE ACT 09-20

AN ACT AMENDING LEGISLATIVE ACT #15-19 AUTHORIZING THE COMPREHENSIVE OPERATING BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020 – Mod. 9; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION:

SECTION 1. TITLE AND CODIFICATION

This legislative act shall be titled and codified as "An Act Amending Legislative Act #15-19 Authorizing the Comprehensive Operating Budget for FY 2020 – Mod. 9".

SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize and approve the use of funds, subject to the availability of such funds, in accordance with Section 4, changing the amounts of certain cost centers approved in the "Comprehensive Budget Act for Fiscal Year 2020" or subsequent amendment. The cumulative total of the budget is increased by \$ 234,534,402 for a total budget authority of \$1,374,679,499. The following items are identified as components of such change:

Cumulative change in budget authority	\$ 234,534,402
Modification Request (see Section 4 below)	232,203,629
Grants Received & Authorized per LA 15-19 (detail attached)	\$ 2,330,773

SECTION 3. <u>LEGISLATIVE HISTORY</u>

The provisions of compliance, policy of accountability, authorities and severability provided in Legislative Act #15-19 are applicable to this amendment.

SECTION 4. <u>FUNDING AUTHORIZATIONS</u>

The changes reflect increases to cost centers set forth in the program budget justifications incorporated herein. This modification request changes the total amount of the comprehensive budget authorization by an increase of \$232,203,629 to wit:

- A. An increase in the **DOI Self Governance** budget authority of \$ 125,000.
- B. An increase in the **Federal Other** budget authority of \$ 232,078,629.

SECTION 5. PROVISIONS AS CUMULATIVE

The provisions of this Act shall be cumulative to existing law.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Act are severable and if any part or provision hereof shall be held void, the decision of the court so holding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts or provisions of this Act.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE: EMERGENCY DECLARED

It being immediately necessary for the welfare of the Cherokee Nation, the Council hereby declares that an emergency exists, by reason whereof this Act shall take effect immediately upon its approval and signatures.

SECTION 8. <u>SELF-HELP CONTRIBUTIONS</u>

To the extent that this Act involves programs or services to citizens of the Nation or others, self-help contributions shall be required, unless specifically prohibited by the funding agency, or a waiver is granted due to physical or mental incapacity of the participant to contribute.

- 1. <u>SG General Assistance 3222220 DOI Self Governance:</u> Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$125,000 for client services to make it through the end of the fiscal year. The new budget total is \$1,425,000.
- CARES Act COVID 19 3750990 Federal Other: Modification requesting an increase in expenditure authorization of \$232,078,629. The budget is to administer the funds to be received from the Department of Treasury under the CARES Act funds. This brings the

current budget total to \$332,078,629. This represents Cherokee Nation's allocation based on tribal population (60% of the total \$8 billion funding). The remaining 40% is to be based on employees and expenditures and will follow later. In addition, per a court order, Treasury is holding the allocations to the ANC's until the lawsuit is resolved and could result in a relatively small third allocation.

Summary:

After reviewing the submission of the operating modification by administration, I find no technical issues surrounding these requests, nor do I have any unmentioned concerns related to their respective carryover estimates. Program Narrative: The General Assistance Program is funded through the Bureau of Indian Affairs and administered through Human Services in the Family Assistance Department.

This program is a financial assistance service for eligible Indian families to address essential living needs (food, clothing and shelter). Assistance is based on welfare payment standards and is considered a secondary resource to the Department of Human Services TANF program and Social Security SSI program. Families who are eliqible for TANF and SSI are required by federal regulations to apply and comply with their guidelines and requirements.

This program also funds emergency disaster assistance to aide families that have losses due to fire or acts of nature. These funds are also used for burial assistance for indigent families.

Specific intended outcomes: To assist with essential living needs, emergency disaster assistance, and burial assistance.

Metrics used to evaluate the effectiveness of the program: Currently, the metrics used to evaluate this program is the number of contacts made and assistance given.

Number of participants served:

Actuals FY 2017: 2,738 General Assistance, 37 Emergency Assistance, 377 Burial

Actuals FY 2018: 2,566 General Assistance, 25 Emergency Assistance, 301 Burial

Actuals for FY 2019 as of March 31, 2019: 1,344 General Assistance, 68 Emergency Assistance, 149 Burial

Projected to be served for the remainder of FY 2019: 2,600, 80, 300

Number of Cherokees served: This program does not track the Tribes of each participant.

Number of non-Cherokees served: This program only serves Native American household, although there may be non-Indians in these households that benefit from the assistance, but the program does not track the number of non-Indians that benefit from these benefits.

Success rates and rationale for measure: Success rates are determined by the number of clients who received assistance through the General Assistance Program.

Reasons for changes in staffing patterns: Only services are charged on this budget.

List the departments and outside entities with which you collaborate with: We collaborate with programs such as Housing, Health and other Human Services groups with Cherokee Nation. Externally, are collaborating with the department of Human Services, Social Security and other Community Action Agencies.

Significant changes made to the program or funding: There have been no significant changes made to this funding.

SIGNIFICANT CHANGES:

We need additional funds for client services due to an increase in services such as burial assistance and other normal day-to-day requests, but also because of natural disasters that have occurred recently—the tornado victims from earlier in the year and the flood victims since mid-May of this year. These benefits are typically \$1,000 per applicant and we have received over 100 applications.

PROGRAM NARRATIVE:				

This budget is to administer the funds to be received from the Department of Treasury under the CARES Act to cover unbudgeted, necessary expenditures incurred due to COVID-19 between March 1, 2020 and December 30, 2020. Treasury determined that 60% of the \$8b will be allocated based on the Tribes' population*, and 40% will be allocated based on employees and expenditures. The \$332,078,629 represents Cherokee Nation's (CN) allocation of the 60% based on tribal population. We will receive a second distribution for our allocation of the remaining 40% of the fund. Also, per a court order, Treasury is holding the allocations to ANCs until the lawsuit is resolved. If it is determined that ANCs are not eligible to receive these funds, CN will receive a 3rd allocation, but that is expected to be relatively small.

*Treasury will use the same Tribal population data as used by the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) in connection with the Indian Housing Block Grant (IHBG) program.
