CALL TO ORDER

Chair Hoskin Jr. called the meeting to order at 1:15 p.m.

INVOCATION

Councilor Byrd gave the invocation.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Councilor Anglen moved to approve the October 25th regular session minutes. Councilor Garvin seconded the motion. The motion carried.

AMEND THE AGENDA

Councilor Hargis moved to amend the agenda to move new business item #8 the Discussion Regarding the Cherokee Nation Courthouse prior to the reports. Councilor Byrd seconded the motion. A friendly amendment was accepted to add for consideration a resolution recognizing Markwayne Mullin and an Act amending the mixed beverage Act. The motion carried.

8. TMP-240 DISCUSSION REGARDING THE CHEROKEE NATION COURT HOUSE

The Supreme Court Justices, the District Court Judges and the Supreme Court Clerk provided a power point presentation pertaining to the Supreme Court House of the Cherokee Nation and their need for a new building.

REPORTS:

Chair Hoskin Jr. requested the reports be brief due to our lengthy agenda.

Marshal Service - Shannon Buhl

Mr. Buhl reported for the Council members who are interested a concealed carry class has been scheduled for January 31st. He offered to answer questions from the report provided.

Office of the Attorney General - Todd Hembree

Mr. Hembree provided an update on the Freedman suits and the UKB issues. He offered to answer questions from the report provided. Mr. Hembree reported the contracts have been signed for the codification process and the work has been done. He provided an update on the South Carolina case. They are in ongoing negotiations with the motor vehicle tag compact and will begin negotiations on the tobacco compact soon. He offered to answer questions from the report provided. Questions were asked pertaining to the Freedman information on the website, the Natchez Nation, the negotiations on the motor vehicle tag compact, the FOIA and GRA processes and the water rights and quality issues.

Codification - Todd Hembree

The codification report was provided during the Attorney General report.

Election Commission - Bill W. Horton

Mr. Horton offered to answer questions from the report provided. Councilor Cowan Watts inquired and had several questions about the rules and regulations provided with the report. Councilor Lay extended an invitation to his community meeting in Nowata next Tuesday. Several questions and concerns were voiced.
