After some questions and clarification Councilor Glory Jordan offered a friendly amendment to make it non-assignable, if the property is sold the easement is immediately terminated and reverts back to the Tribe. The friendly was accepted. Councilor Glory Jordan requested the appraisal information be brought back once it is complete.

The motion to approve with the friendly amendment carried with Councilor Lay abstaining and Councilor Walkingstick opposed.
