REPORTS:

Talking Leaves Job Corp/Career Services/Voc. Ed - Diane Kelley

Ms. Kelley gave an update on the staffing changes within her department. She reminded everyone April is Disability Awareness Month. They are looking to have a new office location for Talking Leaves.
