STATE OF THE NATION Bill John Baker

Principal Chief

Chief Baker announced earlier today he and Deputy Chief Crittenden attended the REZ Conference at the Hard Rock Hotel and Casino where economic development ideas are shared between fellow Native Americans. Last week the Remember the Removal Bike Riders were welcomed back home. The tribe has made a \$75,000 donation to several community organizations to better insure children get snacks and school supplies when school starts. He reminded everyone the application process for the school clothing vouchers is now open. They will host At Large meeting this weekend in New Mexico and Denver. A meeting will be held next week in regard to the Native American Veteran's Memorial in Washington D. C. He gave special recognition to Cherokee citizen Chance Fletcher who hiked the trial of tears from Red

Clay back to Oklahoma. Chief Baker requested a moment of silence to remember those Cherokees who we have lost over the last month.

Monthly Reports:

Housing Authority - Gary Cooper

Mr. Cooper announced the next board meeting for the Housing Authority will be held on Tuesday, July 19th at 5:30. He provided an update in the newly acquired Rehab program. The applications for the College Housing program will be taken from July 25th through the 5th of August. He reported on the monthly impact the Housing Authority programs provide to Cherokee families. As of the end of May they have 249 employees with 95.2% of those being Cherokee and a total Native American employment of 98.4%. He provided an update on the Formulated Negotiated Rule Making Committee for NAHASDA. Councilor Taylor inquired if the majority of the rehab applications are from the elderly. Speaker Byrd inquired if the veteran's funding for housing grant has been received. He commented the Council formed a work group in regard to the rehab program and requested to meet with him to share their ideas and recommendation.

Cherokee Nation Business, LLC - Shawn Slaton

Mr. Slaton reported on the April financials. He gave an update on the Grove casino project and its recently held topping out ceremony. Cultural Tourism is offering a free family friendly story telling events on Wednesdays in July at the gazebo in the Cherokee Capitol Square. He provided an update on their employment numbers including an 80.6% Native American employment percentage.
