APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Councilor Hargis moved to approve the July 12th regular session minutes as submitted. Councilor Walkingstick seconded the motion. The motion carried.

REPORTS:

1. Human Services Department - Marsha Lamb

Ms. Lamb requested Kara Whitworth, the Director of Child Support, to give a brief overview of her program. Ms. Whitworth introduced Sara Quetone as the Program Manager. They provided a packet of information and gave an overview. Several follow-up questions were asked about the program. August is National Child Support Awareness Month. Councilor Walkingstick voiced concern for the Clothing Voucher program using Stage stores only. Ms. Lamb reported they served close to 7,000 children with the clothing vouchers this year. She provided an update on the Veterans trip this fall.

2. Community Services - Ron Qualls

Mr. Qualls announced Jackie Copin has taken the position recently vacated by Ashley Canoe. He offered to answer questions from the report provided. Councilor

Buzzard inquired about the Kenwood waterline and sewer line being contracted.

3. Housing Services - Gary Cooper

Mr. Cooper reported they are processing all of the college housing applications. They are in the process of updating fifty families currently for housing rehab. The housing rehab staff here in Tahlequah will be relocated to the model homes. Councilor Thornton inquired if the applications for the rehab program using the discretionary funds have changed. He inquired about a report from the Council work group in regard to housing rehab. Questions were asked in regard to how many of the fifty applications for rehab were elderly and how many other rehab applications remain. Councilor Buzzard inquired about the process when a contractor turns back projects. He also inquired what happened to the old air conditioners once replaced. Councilor Crittenden requested clarification on the process for rehab. He also inquired about the rental assistance program and the empty homes in the Hogner Heights and Bushyhead additions.

Mr. Lynn gave a brief update on some of their current projects. Councilor Austin requested clarification on Sequoyah West.
