REPORTS:

Management Resources - Bruce Davis

Mr. Davis offered to answer questions from the report provided. Councilor Byrd inquired if they have been to the property involved within the resolution to be discussed during old business today.

2. Real Estate Services - Ginger Brown Reeves

Ms. Reeves offered to answer questions from the report provided. Councilor Lay inquired about the discussion in Washington about doing away with their federal lands and if any of those lands are within our jurisdiction.
