returned from hosting Cherokee Days at the Smithsonian National Museum of the American Indian. Chief Baker took a moment to recognize the 2017 Remember the Removal Bike Riders. Speaker Byrd recognized Dr. Mike Morris as the founder of the bike ride following our trail of tears. Chief Baker requested a moment of silence to remember the long list of Cherokees who we have lost over the last month.

Cherokee Nation Business, LLC - Shawn Slaton

Mr. Slaton reported on the financials from March. He gave updates on the new pool at Hard Rock, the renovations at Will Rogers Downs and the pavement at the Redbird Clinic. Their Cultural Tourism group is hosting a lunch time discussion to highlight the history of Cherokee National Female Seminary at the John Ross Museum on April 21st. The current employment at CNB is 6,674 with 4,788 when the contract and temporary employees are excluded. Of those 4,788 the Cherokee percentage is 73.5% with other Native Americans at 6.8% giving a total Native American employment of 80.3%. He gave an update on the water main break in the Hard Rock tower. He offered to answer questions.
