CALL TO ORDER

Chair Byrd called the meeting to order at 10:14 a.m.

INVOCATION

Councilor Thornton gave the invocation.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Councilor Anglen moved to approve the June 20th regular session minutes as submitted. Councilor Baker seconded the motion. The motion carried.

REPORTS:

Marshal Service - Shannon Buhl

Marshal Buhl reported on the federal investigation being held in Adair County. They have been active in Sequoyah County with the new Sheriff on a few issues. They have settled in to their new accommodations next to the emergency services. He offered to answer questions from the report. Councilor Austin gave appreciation for the Marshal Service attendance at his recently held community meeting.

Office of the Attorney General - Todd Hembree

Ms. Nimmo reported for Attorney General Hembree. Ms. Nimmo announced the United Keetoowah Band has filed an appeal in the 76 acre case. We have filed our response in the Northern District to the Opioid case. She announced they are in the process of moving into their new offices upstairs. Councilor Buzzard requested a brief overview of

tribal relinquishments. Councilor Taylor inquired about the Mississippi Choctaws decision and its effect on our Opioid case. Councilor Thornton requested clarification on dual citizenship.

FOIA-GRA - Gwen Terrapin

Ms. Terrapin announced they have had 4 new FOIA requests since the last meeting. Of the 10 requests this year 3 are outstanding at this time. There have been 2 GRA requests this year and none are outstanding at this time. The website has been updated. She offered to answer questions.

Election Commission - Connie Parnell

Ms. Connie Parnell and Commissioner Shawna Calico reported. They offered to answer questions. Councilor Buzzard inquired about the difference in registered voters between districts 7 and 8. Councilor Crittenden inquired if they are getting some of the address issues corrected in Adair County. Councilor Hargis requested clarification on what is considered highway 59 with the Election Commission, is it 2nd street or the bypass. Councilor Lay inquired if the vacant staff positions have been filled within their office. Councilor Anglen inquired about those who were allowed to pick a district when they lived at large and it has now changed, can they go back to the district they picked. He also inquired people registered to vote in one district has to go outside their district to a polling place.

Tax Commission - Sharon Swepston

Ms. Swepston offered to answer questions from the report provided. Councilor Taylor requested clarification on dates given in the report.

Self-Governance - Karen Ketcher

Ms. Ketcher offered to answer questions from the report provided. Chair Byrd inquired how the USDA proposals are progressing. He requested an organizational chart within the Cherokee Nation.

Gaming Commission - Jamie Hummingbird

Mr. Hummingbird wasn't present to report. Councilor Buzzard inquired if they have a staff attorney. Councilor Walkingstick inquired about the gaming compact. Attorney General Hembree addressed both questions.

Human Resources - Nason Morton

Mr. Morton provided follow up information from questions asked during the last meeting including tracking transfers within the Cherokee Nation, teacher's summer paychecks, and adoption leave. He offered to answer questions from the report provided. Councilor Walkingstick inquired if all employees at Sequoyah are on contract. He inquired if a contracted employee could run for office without resigning their position. Councilor Walkingstick inquired about the teachers not receiving the Cherokee Nation bonuses. Councilor Austin requested clarification on the definition of the word placement when used in regard to adoption.
