CALL TO ORDER

Chair Taylor called the meeting to order at 3:47 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Councilor Hargis moved to approve the July 31st regular session minutes. Councilor Jordan seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Chair Taylor requested the reports be kept very brief and allow Council to ask questions.

Cherokee Nation Businesses - Shawn Slaton

Mr. Slaton announced we made \$11ml in June. Councilor Walkingstick inquired as to how that compares to last year in June.

Financial Report/Treasurer Report - Lacey Horn

Ms. Horn offered to answer questions.

Career Services/Employment - Diane Kelley

Ms. Kelley announced project jupiter in Tulsa would be hiring sixty people by October 15th. A groundbreaking would be held for project robin hood on September 7th in Tulsa. She said there are over one-hundred entries for the parade Saturday.

Commerce - Anna Knight

Ms. Knight provided the Council with bags of coffee beans from the Kawi Café. She announced they received a \$500,000 USDA grant for their revolving small business loan fund and a \$119,000 grant to do a feasibility study health care innovation center incubator. Councilor Baker Shaw requested clarification on the incubator.

Councilor Walkingstick requested \$500 to the New Greenleaf Baptist Church and \$250

to the Dry Creek Community Building. Councilor Austin requested \$1,000 to the Rogers County Youth Services, \$500 to the Verdigris JOM, and \$500 for Chelsea Ministries. Councilor Hargis moved to approve as amended. Councilor Jordan seconded the motion. The motion carried.
