Human Services Department - Marsha Lamb

Ms. Lamb provided a report on the LIHEAP program. She offered to answer questions from the report.

Community Services - Ron Qualls

Mr. Billy Hix reported in the absence of Mr. Qualls. Councilor Buzzard requested clarification on a water and sewer applicants who purchase from individuals.

Roads & Transportation - Michael Lynn

Housing Services - Gary Cooper

Mr. Cooper offered to answer questions from the report provided. He announced they currently have 235 employees at the HACN, 95.3% are Cherokee and 98.7% are Native American. Councilor Buzzard inquired about a timeline for a new home. Chair Lay inquired of those several hundred on lined up for housing are they with land or without. He requested details about the process and the phases for homeowner applicants. Councilor Smith inquired if the homes are by area or application date. Councilor Byrd inquired what applicants are told if they ask where they are in the process for new homeownership.

Commerce Housing Report - Anna Knight

Ms. Knight offered to answer questions from the report provided. Councilor Dobbins inquired about the status of the request for financial information on the change in the I-save program. Councilor Buzzard requested clarification on the Commerce Department using the 184 loan program versus the HACN using the program.
