CALL TO ORDER

Chair Byrd called the meeting to order at 10:10 a.m.

Chair Byrd gave the invocation.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Councilor Taylor made a motion to approve the October 26th regular session minutes. Councilor Vazquez seconded the motion. The motion carried.

REPORTS:

Marshal Service - Shannon Buhl

Marshal Buhl reported they started active shooter response training last week. He offered to answer questions from the report.

Office of the Attorney General - Chrissi Nimmo

Ms. Nimmo reported they are hiring a new attorney and will introduce her next month. Chair Byrd requested a brief update on the Murphy case ruling.

FOIA-GRA - Gwen Terrapin

Ms. Terrapin reported there are currently 18 FOIA requests with 2 of those being new and 6 are outstanding. There are 6 total GRA's with 2 of those being new requests and the other 4 are outstanding. The website has been updated.

Self-Governance - Karen Ketcher

No one was available to report.

Gaming Commission - Jamie Hummingbird

Ms. Debra Wilson reported in the absence of Mr. Hummingbird. On September 28th NIGC announced a notice of proposed rulemaking that would amend 25CFR547.5 which is class II minimal technical standards to remove the sunset date for certain gaming systems. She offered to answer questions from the report.

Tax Commission - Sharon Swepston

Ms. Swepston provided clarification on the Cherokee Nation Veteran tax exempt card issues. She offered to answer questions from the report. Councilor Warner inquired about the search for staff at the Sallisaw tag office.

Human Resources - Nason Morton

Mr. Morton was not available to report.

OLD BUSINESS

1. 17-109 A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE REAPPOINTMENT OF DEACON TURNER AS A BOARD MEMBER OF CHEROKEE NATION BUSINESSES, LLC

Councilor Taylor moved to approve. Councilor Vazquez seconded the motion. Mr. Turner was available for any questions. The motion carried with Councilor Crittenden opposed.

2. 17-126 ACT RELATING TO AMENDMENT OF TITLE 18 ARTICLE 3 SECTION 18 OF THE CHEROKEE NATION GENERAL CORPORATION ACT, INCREASING THE DIVIDENDS, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Councilor Lay made a motion for discussion only. Councilor Vazquez seconded the motion. Councilor Lay requested Treasurer Horn and Assistant Attorney General Harsha to join our Council Attorney to provide an overview of this amendment. He stated he and Council Attorney Nofire Blakestad drafted the Title 18 amendment increasing the dividend another 2%. Treasurer Horn has been working toward a similar goal of a permanent fund and thinks they can be combined. He requested Ms. Horn provide an overview of the changes.

Councilor Lay requested these be combined and brought forward for consideration next month. He requested clarification on the requirement for a 2/3rds vote of the Council and the Principal Chief to expend the funding.

NEW BUSINESS

1. 17-128 A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE REAPPOINTMENT OF CAROLYN ALLEN AS THE FIFTH MEMBER OF THE CHEROKEE NATION ELECTION COMMISSION

Councilor Jordan moved to approve. Councilor Taylor seconded the motion. Councilor Lay made a motion to table. The motion failed for the lack of a second. The motion to approve carried with Councilor Lay opposed.

2. 17-129 A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF GARY DAN DAVIS AS A

BOARD MEMBER OF CHEROKEE NATION FOUNDATION

Councilor Warner made a motion to approve. Councilor Taylor seconded the motion. The motion carried.

3. 17-130 A RESOLUTION APPROVING A TREASURY SERVICES AGREEMENT AND GRANTING A LIMITED CONSENT TO BE SUED

Councilor Taylor moved to approve. Councilor Vazquez seconded the motion. Chair Byrd requested an overview of the request. The motion to approve carried.
