*Mr.* Slaton reported on the April financials. He gave an update on the projects at Hard Rock and the Cherokee Plaza. He announced next year in May we will sponsor the Bass Master fishing tournament at Lake Ft. Gibson with weigh-ins being held at the Cherokee Plaza in front of the casino. They hope to be in the casino in late March. The groundbreaking for the retail portion of the Cherokee Plaza will be held at the end of this week if the weather permits. The first occupant will be Newk's Eatery. He gave an update on the diversified businesses with two new army contracts. The Tourism department will be hosting stories on the Square on Wednesdays in July. Details were given in regard to the new exhibit at the Cherokee Nation Prison Museum. Current employment numbers were given with a Native American employment percentage of 80.1%. He offered to answer questions from the report. Councilor Walkingstick requested clarification on the army contracts. He also inquired about the use of the Woodmark building. Mr. Slaton stated he wouldn't be able to report to the Executive and Finance Committee tomorrow morning. Speaker Byrd gave appreciation for their assistance with the hosting of the Sovereignty Play.
