Chief Baker announced they finalized a partnership with the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service to create a conservation district on Sallisaw creek in Sequoyah County to protect the endangered American bearing beetle. The Cherokee Nation purchased just over sixty acres near the historic Oaks Mission in Delaware County. A road was dedicated in Vinita. We continue to provide our financial support six area domestic abuse shelters. Chief Baker touched on the upcoming National holiday. He was honored to introduce, Fighting Peacocks of Delaware County, a team of Cherokee citizens representing Oklahoma and the Cherokee Nation at the 2018 USA Special

Olympics. Chief Baker read a long list of Cherokees who have passed over the last month and requested a moment of silence.
