APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Councilor Hargis moved to approve the August 13th regular session minutes. Councilor Taylor seconded the motion. The motion carried.

REPORTS:

1. Management Resources - Bruce Davis

Mr. Davis gave an update from the recently held Cherokee National Holiday. He gave appreciation to all of the employees helped with the success of the event. He offered to answer questions from the report. Councilor Byrd requested suggestions on where we could improve especially the areas we have outgrown for the holiday events. Councilor Taylor stated she received compliments on the changes made at the powwow grounds. Councilor Shaw suggested additional lighting in the parking areas at the powwow.
