## APPROVAL OF MINUTES

#### **REPORTS**:

Marshal Service - Shannon Buhl

*Mr.* Scot Craig offered to answer questions from the report provided. Councilor Walkingstick asked for an update on the Marshals pay.

Office of the Attorney General - Chrissi Nimmo

Ms. Nimmo reported the stay had been denied in the ICWA case in Texas. She provided a more in depth update regarding the case. She also provided an update in the DC Nash case. She offered to answer questions. Councilor Walkingstick requested an update on the Murphy Case. Councilor Buzzard inquired about the UKB cases. Chair Byrd asked about the 47 Act also known as the Stigler Act. FOIA-GRA - Gwen Terrapin

*Ms.* Terrapin reported there are 17 total requests, 14 of those are FOIA and 3 are GRA. At this time none are outstanding and the website has been updated.

Tax Commission - Sharon Swepston

*Ms.* Swepston corrected the next meeting of the Tax Commission board. She offered to answer questions from the board.

Gaming Commission - Jamie Hummingbird

*Mr.* Hummingbird offered to answer questions from the report. The NIGC recently commemorated the 30-year anniversary of the passage of the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act. He stated the construction projects for Tahlequah and Catoosa are on time. They are in the process of doing their end of year reviews for facility licenses. They have combined the November and December board meetings to December 7th. The following Wednesday will be the all CNG staff meeting at the community meeting room here at the complex.
