CALL TO ORDER

Chair Vazquez called the meeting to order at 9:01 a.m.

INVOCATION

Councilor Taylor gave the invocation.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Councilor Warner moved to approve the May 30th regular session minutes as submitted. Councilor Duncan seconded the motion. The motion carried.

REPORTS:

Cultural Tourism - Molly Jarvis

Ms. Jarvis gave an overview and update of the report provided. Councilor Shaw asked if the National Treasures for the year have been chosen and if so how many, their fields and the number nominated. Councilor Crittenden inquired about the bus tour to North Carolina. Councilor Byrd invited Ms. Jarvis and her staff to attend the Marshal Museum meeting in Ft. Smith.

Cherokee Nation Language Program - Roy Boney / John Ross

Mr. Boney gave an update from the report provided. A Resolution Calling for a State of Emergency for the Language was passed and signed at Tri-Council. A request has been made to form a committee representing each of the three tribes for the Language

State of Emergency. He reported on the Consortium meeting, the Ignite Conference and the Presentations at the CCO Conference. Starting tomorrow the Inter-Tribal Language Work Group will host a workshop in Ada for the tribal language programs. Councilor Shaw inquired if the language speakers are paid for their gas and other expenses for teaching classes. Councilor Byrd requested information on increasing the stipend for the language program. Councilor Crittenden suggested providing an incentive for the younger generation to learn the language. Councilor Hatfield gave appreciation for the language books.

Community & Cultural Outreach - Kevin Stretch

Mr. Stretch reported on the language program participants, the number enrolled, the issues and difficuilties. They currently have three teachers. Councilors inquired about the number of applications for the program per year, the capacity, the teacher to student ratio, and the teacher qualifications. Councilor Warner suggested everyone go over and spend time with the language program. Councilor Byrd suggested trying to recruit speakers in the communities to come and teach once or twice a week.

Historical Society - Charles Gourd

Dr. Gourd reported they are gearing up for the holiday activities. The deadline for the art show is this Friday. He spoke about the upcoming fall exhibit about Cherokee's in baseball. We will host the Five Tribes Genealogy Conference this year. He reported on the outreach program and the upcoming fundraising gala. He offered to answer questions from the report provided. Councilor Shaw requested an update on the archives facility. She inquired about the proposed location of the archive facility, the Heritage Center property ownership, placement in trust process, the operating budget, and what it would take to bring back under the Cherokee Nation. Councilor Byrd inquired what resources are needed from the Cherokee Nation. He requested a show of committee members hands as to who would be in agreement to move forward with the process.
