Management Resources - David Moore

Mr. Harsha extended an invitation to the Council to attend a conference being held at the Hard Rock November 5th through the 7th. They have preparations underway for the Regional Tribal Operations Committee of the EPA being held at the Hard Rock on the 19th and 20th of November. He provided an update on the seed bank. He offered to answer questions from the report. Councilor Shambaugh inquired if there are any proposed changes to the Hunting and Fishing Compact. He commented on including archery as it is a part of our heritage.
