REPORTS:

Claremore Service Unit - George Valliere

Mr. Valliere gave an update from the report provided. He offered to answer questions from the report. Chair Shaw inquired about the funding available each month for contract health referrals. Councilor Byrd inquired about the number of tribes served and the amount of each tribes contract referral budget. Councilor Shambaugh requested clarification on the PRC activities referred to in the report.

Cherokee Nation Health Services - Dr. Steve Jones

Dr. Jones gave highlights from the report provided. They received notification last week they were approved for an accreditation for family practice residency. They have a new speech therapy program for both inpatient and outpatient. They have a new phone project to determine the issues with the phone system. He reported at this time there isn't a waiting list for primary care providers. He provided an update on the Stilwell clinic project. He requested Ms. Lisa Pivec, Senior Director of Public Health, provide an update and announcement on the life expectancy study and the errors found for Adair County. Mr. Brian Hail provided an update on the Medicade Block Grant and SoonerCare 2.0. Councilor Taylor inquired if it is an either or situation. Dr. Roger Montgomery provided an update on the Corona Virus outbreak. Chair Shambaugh inquired if this is considered a pandemic. Councilor Crittenden inquired about treatments for the virus. Councilor Buzzard inquired if mask area available here at the complex. Councilor Shaw requested an update on the Tramadol shortage. Councilor Nofire inquired if Northeast Health System losing their accreditation would affect our joint venture. He also requested clarification on the lighting and the coffee at the new outpatient clinic. Councilor Dobbins inquired about the long-term outlook for our accreditation for the family practice residency. Councilor Crittenden requested an update on the notifications going out to creditors in relation to patients getting contract referrals. He inquired about the payment process for the contract referrals. Chair Shaw inquired if there is behavior health help after hours and if the services are available for At Large citizens. She also inquired about the policy on counseling when getting prescriptions.
