REPORTS:

Management Resources - David Moore

Mr. Moore gave an update from the report provided. The buffalo were received from Yellowstone. Two of the hypocaloric machines are up and running at this time. He gave an update on the OSU medical school and Wilma P. Mankiller Clinic construction projects. He offered to answer questions from the report provided. Chair Jordan inquired where the machines are located. Councilor Buzzard inquired where to refer an elder who needs assistance removing tornado debris from her yard. Councilor Smith inquired how to go about getting the cleaning solution from the hypocaloric machine. Chair Byrd suggested a meeting with the Quapaw Nation to review their meat processing operation. Mr. Enlow gave an update at to what the Administration has been working on in regard to the buffalo meat. **Real Estate Services - Ginger Reeves**

Ms. Reeves offered to answer questions from the report provided. Councilor Shaw inquired about the purpose of the four properties recently purchased. Councilor Nofire inquired about the status of the Owens School being reverted back to the tribe. Councilor Crittenden inquired about the status of the Stilwell Airport.

Environmental Programs - Tom Elkins

Secretary Harsha reported in the absence of Mr. Elkins. He reported the COVID-19 sampling the Environmental group is doing is largely after hours.

Secretary of Natural Resources - Chad Harsha

Secretary Harsha have an update on the strides they are making toward having a master plan for the landfill. They will be extending their solar projects across the jurisdiction with a grant. The grant of almost \$6ml will allow for rural electric transit buses and additional solar canopies. He commented on the safety amendment the state is requesting. Councilor Shambaugh requested clarification on what the State is wanting. Councilor Buzzard inquired about the status of the request for copies of all correspondence regarding the pine trees and the status of the meeting with the Bureau of Land Management. Councilor Shaw requested an update on the issuance of temporary fishing licenses for At Large citizens.
