Chair Jordan called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m.

INVOCATION

Councilor Dobbins gave the invocation.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Councilor Taylor made a motion to approve the June regular session minutes. Councilor Dobbins seconded the motion. The motion carried.

REPORTS:

Management Resources - David Moore

Mr. Moore offered to answer questions from the report provided. Councilor Dobbins inquired when the remodel of the Durbin Feeling Language Center would start, how long it would take, and the cost of the renovation.

Real Estate Services - Ginger Reeves

of a fence in a land-locked area.

Councilor Byrd inquired about Mr. Elkins. Councilor Patzkowski requested clarification on the Clean Water Program sampling at four locations referred to in the report.

Secretary of Natural Resources & Environmental Programs - Chad Harsha

Councilor Shaw requested an update on the temporary hunting and/or fishing licenses for At Large citizens visiting the reservation. Councilor Nofire inquired about the annual funding amount from the BIA for forestry and if it could be used for the pine trees in Delaware County. He inquired how much of a financial loss the pines are currently. Councilor Nofire commented on the closing of the Bathtub Rocks here in Cherokee County. Councilor Byrd inquired about the possibility of the tribe purchasing Cherokee Landing on Lake Tenkiller.
