Chair Crittenden called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m.

Vocational Programs/Talking Leaves Job Corp/Career Services - Diane Kelley

Ms. Kelley reported the GED graduation would be virtual. They are promoting but need help recruiting for the childcare program. She offered to answer questions from the report. Councilor Legg inquired about stipend amounts for the programs. Councilor Tehee inquired about the surgical tech program graduates being placed outside of our health system.

Executive Director's Report - Corey Bunch

Mr. Bunch reported they have worked with the Chief's office to help coordinate and deliver PPE products to schools. He stated he would contact the Council by email if they wish to participate. He offered to answer questions from the report provided.

Councilor Vazquez inquired about the partnership with Sparton School of Aeronautics. Chair Crittenden requested clarification if the PPE were being delivered to only those schools with a mask mandate or if it would be all schools in the reservation.

Sequoyah High School - Corey Bunch

Councilor Tehee inquired about the search for the Superintendent position at Sequoyah High School. Councilor Coates inquired about mask mandates at the school, COVID detection rates, COVID testing and athletics this school year. Councilor Dobbins inquired about the number of Sequoyah football players this year and requested an update on the eligibility of those who transferred back. Councilor Dobbins inquired about comparison of this year versus 2019.

Head Start - Verna Thompson

Ms. Thompson offered to answer questions from the report provided. Councilor Shotpouch inquired about COVID within her program. Ms. Thompson announced a couple of initiatives recently started: perfect attendance for the staff and babies. She announced they are recruiting both staff and students.
