CALL TO ORDER

Chair Dobbins called the meeting to order at 12:35 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Councilor Deere moved to approve the minutes as submitted. Councilor Austin seconded the motion. The motion carried.

REPORTS:

Claremore Service Unit - George Valliere

Mr. Valliere provided an update on COVID and gave highlights from the report. Chair Dobbins requested clarification on the COVID report. He inquired as to the number of dental chairs, staff and patients seen at their facility. Councilor Austin inquired about the contract health denials. Councilor Shambaugh inquired as to the main reason for being denied. Councilor Callison inquired if the denial letter stated why and if it was where the citizen could understand. Councilor Patzkowski requested a copy of the denial letter.

Cherokee Nation Health Services - Dr. Steve Jones

Dr. Jones provided highlights from the report. He commented on the health newsletter recently provided by email. He offered to answer questions from the report. Councilor Legg inquired about patients getting multiple bills for contract health. Councilor Crittenden requested a copy of their denial letter. Councilor Callison inquired as to the main reason for a denial. He requested a copy of the rules of contract health be given to the Council. Councilor Kidwell inquired who determines what is considered "risky behavior". Councilor Callison questioned taking third party credit to help people who don't qualify for contract health. He inquired as to the last time the contract health department was reviewed and/or expanded. Councilor Deere requested clarification on a comment pertaining to contract health. Councilor Kidwell inquired if we have an MOU with Muskogee Creek Nation. Councilor Shambaugh inquired about the budget for contract health.

Cherokee Nation Public Health - Lisa Pivec & Dr. David Gahn

Ms. Pivec gave highlights from the report provided. She announced cherokeepublichealth.org has been launched. The Tribal Health Assessment will be on the website in a few weeks. She reported on their efforts to assist in the shortage of infant formula and provided caution on the scams. The Summer Food Program will have a payment increase.

Dr. Gahn provided an update on the COVID numbers, the next variant, and the cases slowly increasing again. Councilor Shambaugh inquired about our status on vaccines.
