### **A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CHEROKEE NATION WAREHOUSE TO DONATE SURPLUS OFFICE EQUIPMENT TO THE JAY MUSEUM IN DELAWARE COUNTY**

**WHEREAS**, the Cherokee Nation since time immemorial has exercised the sovereign rights of self-government on behalf of the Cherokee people;

**WHEREAS**, the Cherokee Nation is a federally recognized Indian Nation with a historic and continual government to government relationship with the United States of America;

**WHEREAS**, the Cherokee Nation Warehouse has the following office equipment in its inventory that has been deemed surplus:

- Book Case, CN # 29288
- Book Case Metal, Black CN # 44721
- 4 Drawer File Cabinets, Black CN # 3789
- Bookshelf, CN # 015129

**WHEREAS**, the Cherokee Nation Warehouse desires to donate this office equipment in “as- is” condition.

**WHEREAS**, the Jay Museum located within the Cherokee Nation jurisdictional boundaries, operates on limited funds and the donation of this office equipment would benefit them greatly.

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION**, that the Tribal Council hereby authorizes Cherokee Warehouse to donate this surplus office equipment to the Jay Museum located in Delaware County as set out above.
