### A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHEROKEE NATION WAREHOUSE TO DONATE SURPLUS ITEMS TO VANN'S LAKE BAPTIST CHURCH

**WHEREAS**, the Cherokee Nation, since time immemorial, has exercised the sovereign rights of self-government on behalf of the Cherokee people.

**WHEREAS** the Cherokee Nation is a federally recognized Indian Nation with a historic and continual government-to-government relationship with the United States of America;

**WHEREAS**, the Cherokee Nation Warehouse has the following items in its inventory that have been deemed surplus:

- 20 stackable chairs
- 10 child chairs
- child cubby
- child play table
- child couch
- ping pong table

The Cherokee Nation Warehouse desires to donate these items in "as-is" condition.

**WHEREAS** the Vann's Lake Baptist Church, located within the Cherokee Nation's jurisdictional boundaries, operates on limited funds, and donating said items would benefit them greatly.

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION** that the Tribal Council authorizes Cherokee Nation Warehouse to donate these surplus items to Vann's Lake Baptist Church as set out above.
