### **A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHEROKEE NATION WAREHOUSE TO DONATE SURPLUS ITEMS TO CALVARY INDIAN BAPTIST CHURCH**

**WHEREAS**, the Cherokee Nation, since time immemorial, has exercised the sovereign rights of self-government on behalf of the Cherokee people.

**WHEREAS** the Cherokee Nation is a federally recognized Indian Nation with a historic and continual government-to-government relationship with the United States of America.

The Cherokee Nation Warehouse desires to donate these items in "as-is" condition.

#### **18- Armoires**

**WHEREAS** the Calvary Indian Baptist Church, located within the Cherokee Nation's jurisdictional boundaries, operates on limited funds, and donating said items would benefit them greatly.

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION** that the Tribal Council authorizes Cherokee Nation Warehouse to donate these surplus items to Calvary Indian Baptist Church as set out above.
