### **A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CHEROKEE NATION WAREHOUSE TO DONATE SURPLUS OFFICE EQUIPMENT TO FAIRFIELD COMMUNITY BUILDING IN ADAIR COUNTY**

**WHEREAS**, the Cherokee Nation since time immemorial has exercised the sovereign rights of self-government on behalf of the Cherokee people;

**WHEREAS**, the Cherokee Nation is a federally recognized Indian Nation with a historic and continual government to government relationship with the United States of America;

**WHEREAS**, the Cherokee Nation Warehouse has the following equipment in its inventory that has been deemed surplus:

- CN #58359      Bookcase
- CN #1294      Black Office Chair
- CN #0623      Office Chair
- CN #1506      Chair
- CN #68932      Stool

**WHEREAS**, the Cherokee Nation Warehouse desires to donate this equipment in “as- is” condition.

**WHEREAS**, the Fairfield Community Building located within the Cherokee Nation jurisdictional boundaries, operates on limited funds and the donation of this office equipment would benefit them greatly.

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION**, that the Tribal Council hereby authorizes

Cherokee Nation Warehouse to donate this surplus office equipment to the Fairfield Community Building located in Adair County as set out above.
