A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE OFFICIAL CHEROKEE NATION WEBSITE TO BE REGISTERED AS A GOVERNMENT DOMAIN UNDER THE NAME OF www.cherokee-nsn.gov

WHEREAS, the Cherokee Nation since time immemorial has exercised the sovereign rights of self-government in behalf of the Cherokee people;

WHEREAS, the Cherokee Nation is a federally recognized Indian Nation with a historic and continual government to government relationship with the United States of America;

WHEREAS, the Cherokee Nation website is maintained by the Information Systems division of the Nation, and is currently registered under the organization domain name of www.cherokee.org

WHEREAS, the Cherokee Nation recognizes the need to provide the Nation’s citizens and the general public access to this information through the Internet in a way that preserves the integrity of the Nation while providing an official and trusted Internet presence;

WHEREAS, as a federally-recognized Indian nation, Cherokee Nation is eligible to register as a Native Sovereign Nation government domain (-NSN.gov) through the U.S Department of the Interior;

WHEREAS, the Cherokee Nation desires to obtain the government domain name of www.cherokee-nsn.gov
<<http://www.cherokee-nsn.gov>>, thus distinguishing the Nation’s current website status of an organization site to that of a government site.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION, that the Tribal Council hereby authorizes Cherokee Nation Information Systems to submit a request to the Chief Information Officer, U.S. Department of the Interior, to register the official Cherokee Nation website as a government domain under the name of www.cherokee-nsn.gov <<http://www.cherokee-nsn.gov>>; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION, that the Principal Chief (or his designee) shall be authorized to execute all official documents in this regard.
