**WHEREAS**, the goal of this project is to incorporate alternative energy sources into the Tahlequah Public Schools system to being an alternative energy movement within the community by educating students of the advantages of alternative energy resources fiscally and environmentally to shape our future citizens and to provide Tahlequah Public Schools with an alternative energy source for its classrooms and facilities for future development; and
