WHEREAS, the Cherokee Nation since time immemorial has exercised the sovereign rights of self-government on behalf of the Cherokee people;

WHEREAS, the Cherokee Nation is a federally recognized Indian Nation with a historic and continual government to government relationship with the United States of America;

WHEREAS, the Cherokee Nation Information Technology Department has the following office equipment in its inventory that has been deemed surplus:

WHEREAS, the Cherokee Nation Information Technology Department desires to donate this office equipment in "as- is" condition.

WHEREAS, the Moffett Police Department located within the Cherokee Nation jurisdictional boundaries, operates on limited funds and the donation of this office equipment would benefit them greatly.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION, that the Tribal Council hereby authorizes Cherokee Information Technology Department to donate this surplus office equipment to the Moffett Police
