### **A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION IN SUPPORT OF THE CREATION OF NATIVE CENTER FOR HEALTH RESEARCH (NARCH-8)**

**WHEREAS**, the Cherokee Nation since time immemorial has exercised the sovereign rights of self-government in behalf of the Cherokee people; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Cherokee Nation is a federally recognized Indian Nation with a historic and continual government to government relationship with the United States of America; and,

**WHEREAS**, Cherokees suffer disproportionately ~~for~~ from Cancer, Heart Disease, Diabetes, Obesity and Osteoarthritis which are the leading causes of premature death and disability within the Cherokee Nation; and,

**WHEREAS**, evidence-based strategies exist to mitigate risk factors for these conditions; and, therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION**, that a collaborative effort to pursue a grant application in support of creation of Native Center for Health research (NARCH-8) is to be completed and submitted for funding to develop and build capacity to implement interventions consistent with, active living, healthy eating, high quality clinical and other preventive services.
