### **A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DONATION OF A 25' FLAG POLE FOR THE PROCTOR CEMETERY LOCATED IN PROCTOR, OKLAHOMA**

**WHEREAS,** the Cherokee Nation since time immemorial has exercised the sovereign rights of self-government in behalf of the Cherokee people and;

**WHEREAS,** the Cherokee Nation is a federally recognized Indian Nation with a historic and continual government to government relationship with the United States of America and;

**WHEREAS,** the Cherokee Nation, has one (1) 25' flag pole that is surplus to the needs of the Cherokee Nation and,

**WHEREAS,** the Proctor Cemetery located in Proctor, Oklahoma, is in need of the flag pole to honor the veteran's in their final resting place, the majority of whom were Cherokee citizens.

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION,** that the Principal Chief of the Cherokee Nation, Bill John Baker, and/or his authorized designee(s) be authorized to execute the donation of one (1) 25' flag pole to the Proctor Cemetery located in Proctor, Oklahoma.
