WHEREAS, the Cherokee Nation is a federally recognized Indian Nation with a historic and continual government to government relationship with the United States of America;

WHEREAS, the Cherokee Nation Vocational Rehabilitation Department has the following equipment in its inventory that has been deemed surplus:

16'x16' Wrestling Ring - No CN #

WHEREAS, the Cherokee Nation Vocational Rehabilitation Department desires to donate this equipment in "as- is" condition.

WHEREAS, the United Wrestling Entertainment Foundation is located within the Cherokee Nation jurisdictional boundaries, operates on limited funds and the donation of this equipment would benefit them greatly.
