WHEREAS, Cherokee Nation Elder Care is a Program of all-inclusive care for the elderly (PACE) designed to keep elders living in their homes, connected with their communities and out of nursing home facilities; and,

WHEREAS, Cherokee Nation Elder Care (PACE) is designed to keep elders living in their homes, connected with their communities and out of the nursing home facilities;

WHEREAS, COVID-19 pandemic has created a need for funding to support the transit industry during the
