### **A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO THE OKLAHOMA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE 2021 FTA CORONAVIRUS RESPONSE AND RELIEF SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT (CRRSA) PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, Cherokee Nation since time immemorial has exercised the sovereign rights of self-government on behalf of the Cherokee people;

**WHEREAS**, Cherokee Nation is a federally recognized Indian Nation with a historic and continual government to government relationship with the United States of America;

**WHEREAS**, Cherokee Nation Elder Care is a Program of all-inclusive care for the elderly (PACE) designed to keep elders living in their homes, connected with their communities and out of nursing home facilities; and,

**WHEREAS**, Cherokee Nation Elder Care (PACE) is designed to keep elders living in their homes, connected with their communities and out of the nursing home facilities;

**WHEREAS**, COVID-19 pandemic has created a need for funding to support the transit industry during the

COVID-19 public health emergency;

**WHEREAS**, Cherokee Nation submitted an application to the Oklahoma Department of Transportation for its FY 2021 FTA Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSA) Program;

**WHEREAS**, Cherokee Nation Elder Care (PACE) requests funding for operational costs.

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION**, that the Tribal Council hereby approves the application as it was submitted to the Oklahoma Department of Transportation Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2021 (CRRSA).
